

SUBJECT: Use of Lemon Lot

1. REFERENCE: Army Regulation 215-1, Morale, Welfare, and Recreation Activities and Nonappropriated Fund Instrumentalities, 1 December 2004.
2. PURPOSE: To establish policy regarding the use of the Lemon Lot.
3. POLICY:
 - a. The Lemon Lot is an MWR operation. Authorized users of the Lemon Lot are active and retired military and Fort Benning DOD civilians. Military or civilian identification (ID) cards are required.
 - b. Patrons will obtain a yellow Lemon Lot ID card from the Outdoor Recreation (ODR) Branch, Building 1707. Patrons will register all vehicles placed on the Lemon Lot (cars, trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles) with the Directorate of Emergency Services (DES), Building 2637, or the Visitor Center, Building 10603. Patrons will provide proof of ownership and insurance. Vehicles will be allowed on the Lemon Lot for 30-day increments. At the end of 30 days, the vehicles will be removed for 7 days and may be re-registered with the ODR Branch and placed back on the Lemon Lot for 30 more days.
 - c. Patrons must check vehicles weekly to ensure vehicles are in good order, i.e., no flat tires, no broken windows, etc. The yellow Lemon Lot ID card must be displayed inside the vehicle in view of customers. Patrons will completely fill out the required information on the yellow Lemon Lot ID card.
 - d. Patrons will be responsible for any cost incurred for removal of vehicle left on the lot without the yellow Lemon Lot ID card.
4. SUPERSESSON: This policy memorandum supersedes USAIC Policy Memorandum 215-1-4, 6 June 2003.
