**Professional**

- On bad days, he got “hammered” by chain of command
- Morale in (b)(6) was low - extremely low regard for CLT/BLT

Ref SSG Flores: (b)(6) told (b)(6) that SSG Flores had taken his life for personal (not professional) reasons – told (b)(6) that “she was taking it harder than Mrs. Flores”

- SSG Flores stated he'd had a very hard, hard week - in at 0630, out at 2200
- she believed the long hours were contributing factor
- threatened w/ relief from job (heard that he'd lost job at (b)(6) )
- Contributing factor - “of course”
- He indicated to her marital problems due to work hours - “hours were killing him”

(b)(6) were “toxic” leaders on a list

- (b)(6) / 79Rs form a clique ... detailed recruiters are “beneath them”
- SFCs working for SSGs

(b)(6) fully understood her rights and all implications of the Privacy Act Statement, providing full testimony without coercion and undue influence.
