 meet her on time before March 5th. On the morning of March 6th, I was in the office at 0700 that morning and received a call

 the situation, I then called my Company Commander to inform him of the situation, About a half hour later, the battalion
 commander called and got my statement, Cassey called me about the same time and she talk to the battalion commander over
 speaker phone at the same time and explained her story. I had lots of calls that day as the situation unfolded, the company
 leadership team and battalion leadership team came to the station that day right before lunch on March 06. Pretty much from
 that point on, I cleaned out his desk and government car and took his weapons to the company as instructed by (9)(q).
 I found no weapons or anything or than personal belongs and recruiting stuff. As the week went along, I found out Cassey had
 passed away and we planned the memorial service and went to the funeral in Portland OR. for Sgt Andersson.

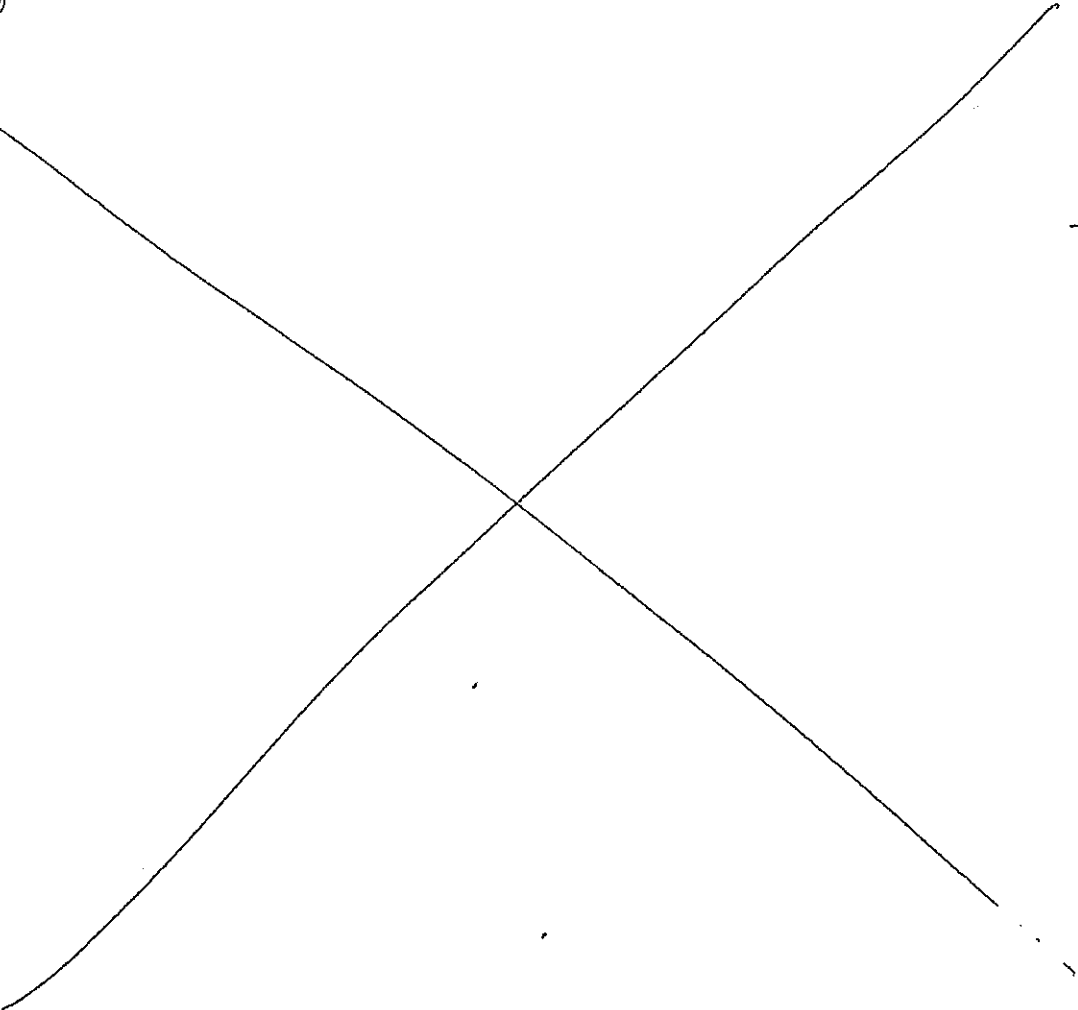
