

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation: (b)(6), US Army
Recruiting Battalion Houston

1. I have reviewed the subject investigation dated 3 April 2007 concerning allegations of misconduct by (b)(6) and the recommendations of the Appointing Authority. The findings and recommendations of the Investigating Officer are approved.
2. I am directing the following actions:
 - a. Allegations against (b)(6) are unsubstantiated. I am informing (b)(6) of, this by a separate memorandum.
 - b. You will work with the Houston Battalion Commander to resolve working relationship issues between the (b)(6). The end result should be a synchronized staff which provides positive command and control over the Houston Battalion.
 - c. You will assist the Houston Battalion Commander in correcting the poor command climate in (b)(6) Company.
 - d. The Battalion Commander will rescind his Leave Pass and Time Off Policy dated 2 March 07, Battalion Policy #13 and replace it with one that is consistent with law and regulation.
