MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Record of Phone Conversation with (b)(6)

1. On Wednesday, 19 Nov 08, at approximately 1050 hrs, I conducted a telephonic interview with (b)(6). I reminded (b)(6) that he was still under oath and he stated that he understood his rights as previously read by (b)(6). (b)(6) fully understood his rights under the Privacy Act. The purpose of this interview was to collect background information as part of an AR 15-6 investigation into the deaths of CPT Rico Robinson sometime between 15-18 Jan 05; SSG Aron Andersson on or about 6 Mar 07; SSG Larry Flores on or about 8 Aug 08; and SFC Patrick Henderson on or about 20 Sep 08. The line of questioning pertained to his relationship with individuals involved in the chain of command. (b)(6) offered the following testimony:

a. I asked (b)(6) if the Brigade Commander had taken any action on low morale? He stated that the only Brigade action was the EO inspection done in Jul 08, nothing was done in 2007.

b. The first time he discussed the 2 Mar 07 Time Off Policy with (b)(6) and (b)(6) was during late Jun/Jul 08. (b)(6), (b)(7)b
