SUBJECT: Phone Conversation with (b)(6)

1. While serving as pseudo-casualty assistance officer, I spoke with (b)(6) concerning CPT Robinson's household goods on or about 27 January 2005. During this conversation I asked (b)(6) what would he like to do with (b)(6) car and motorcycle. He mentioned to me that he would rather just have the lien holders pick them both up. He mentioned that he'd made calls to several of CPT Robinson's creditors and that he had amassed some debt. He was not very specific or detailed about dollar amounts, although he did mention some credit cards.

2. I informed (b)(6) that he did not have to make any statement if he didn't want to. (b)(6) fully understood his rights and all implications of the Privacy Act Statement, providing full testimony without coercion and undue influence.
