SUBJECT: Interview with (b)(6) on 27 January 2005

1. I conducted an interview with (b)(6) and asked her several questions concerning the behavior of CPT Robinson just prior to his death. (b)(6) informed me that she and CPT Robinson met in August of 2005. They started an exclusive relationship in October 2005. They'd had a break-up before the Christmas holiday but reconciled in time to have both of their families come from out of town to eat at CPT Robinson's house. Shortly after the holiday she said that she'd notice a change in CPT Robinson. She said that this change coincided with him taking (b)(3)

(b)(3) (b)(6) also testified that CPT Robinson had become very irritable since his taking the (b)(3). She said that he was not himself and was very moody.

2. I asked (b)(6) what caused the break up. She told me that they both mutually agreed. She said that she told CPT Robinson that she didn't feel he was as committed as she was and he told her that he felt he needed some space. They both agreed and she said the break up was very amiable at that point. They both agreed to continue the friendship and still see each other often. This was 9 January 2005. On the morning of 10 January 2005, (b)(6) found e-mail on CPT Robinson's computer that made it appear that he had not been completely honest with her. She e-mailed him to let him know that she did not want to have anything to do with him again. (b)(6) (b)(6) says that he called her continuously from 10-14 January 2005 and she would not answer his calls.

5. I asked (b)(6) what made her go over to see CPT Robinson when she finally did (18 January). She said that after speaking with a friend at work, she helped her realize that she still cared and that she should try and work things out. She then told me that she spoke with CPT Robinson's (b)(6) and she told her that she spoke with CPT Robinson on 14 January and he made comments like, "tell everyone I love them." (b)(6) said that (b)(6) asked her to go by and check on CPT Robinson.
