SUBJECT: Authorized Heraldry for the U.S. Army Medical Readiness Command, Europe

1. As a result of the redesignation of the Regional Health Command, Europe to the U.S. Army Medical Readiness Command, Europe, the following heraldic items are redesignated effective 14 April 2022:

a. A distinctive unit insignia:

(1) **Originally approved** for the Europe Regional Medical Command on 27 November 2012.

(2) **Redesignated** effective 01 October 2016 for the U.S. Army Regional Health Command, Europe with symbolism updated.

b. A distinguishing flag IAW TIOH Drawing No. 5-1-0777.

2. Enclosed for your use and retention are:

a. TIOH Drawing D-6902.

b. Artwork in color.

3. The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command is responsible for the procurement of flags. 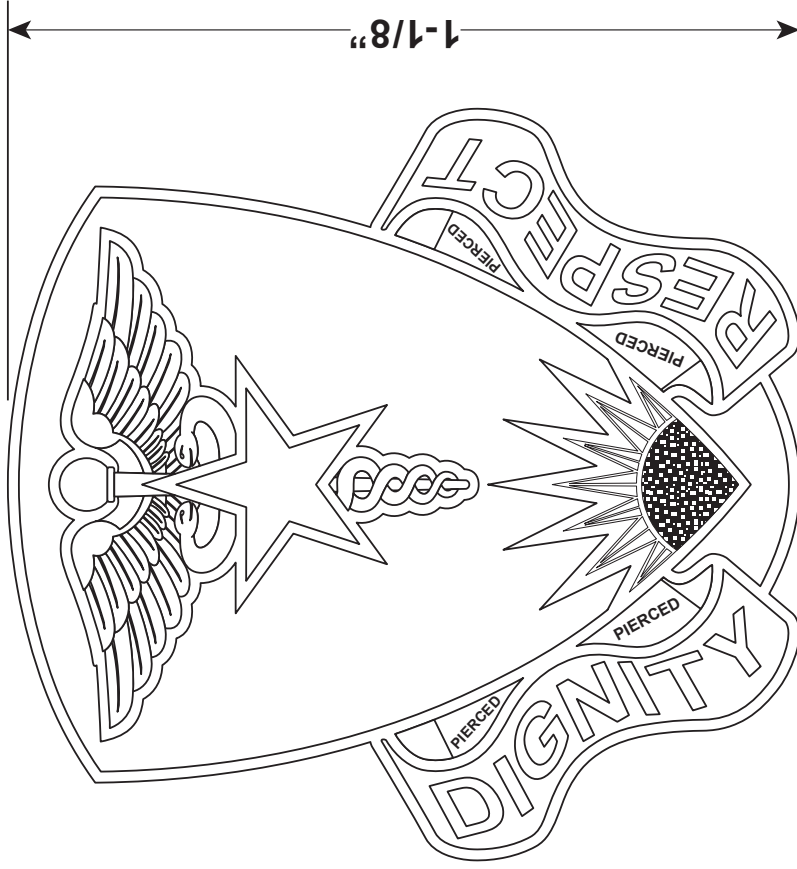

DISTINCTIVE UNIT INSIGNIA

Description. A silver metal and epoxied shield shaped device 1-1/8 inch (2.86 cm) in height blazoned as follows: Sanguine, a caduceus surmounted by a mullet Azure, issuant from base a demi-sunburst with seven rays exposed Or. Attached below and to the sides of the shield a tripartite blue scroll inscribed “DIGNITY” and “RESPECT” in silver letters.

Symbolism. Maroon is the color associated with the U.S. Army Medical Department and the caduceus is a symbol used by military medical organizations. The shield shape alludes to the U.S. Army Europe shoulder sleeve insignia, representing the two roles the Commander holds as Medical Readiness Command, Europe Commander and the U.S. Army Europe Command Surgeon. The blue star was a symbol of the original U.S. Medical Command Europe. The rising sun denotes hope, for the Command is the first stop for warriors injured on the battlefield. The seven exposed rays symbolize the Command’s roots as the 7th Medical Command. The motto reflects the foundations that the Command is built upon.

Background. The distinctive unit insignia was originally approved for the Europe Regional Medical Command on 27 November 2012. It was redesignated effective 1 October 2016, for the U.S. Army Regional Health Command, Europe with the symbolism updated. It was redesignated 14 April 2022 for the Medical Readiness Command, Europe.

Mission: Ensure delivery of healthcare services for eligible beneficiaries within assigned area of responsibility within MEDCOM. Provide regional support to Medical Department Activities (MEDDAC), Medical Centers (MEDCEN), Dental Health Commands (DHC), Public Health Commands (PHC), and branches, and sections at levels equivalent to the support provided to a dental or medical activity by the collocated MEDCEN, MEDDAC, or health clinic.

Effective date: 1 October 2022

(c) Unit organization and manpower structure will be documented on the MRC, Europe (W08QAA) FY23 TDA.

(d) Logistical support will be provided by MEDCOM (W3VYAA).

(e) Uniform Code of Military Justice Authority is designated in accordance with Army in Europe Regulation 27-10 and Commanding General, U.S. Army Europe policy and subordinate General Court-Martial Convening Authority UCMJ policy memoranda.

(f) Commander will ensure coordination with the appropriate servicing civilian personnel support offices to complete labor obligations (if applicable) and to effect any necessary changes in appropriate civilian personnel data and pay systems to update civilian personnel and pay records.
