Third Judicial Circuit

On 11 May 2021, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Riley, Kansas, PFC Christopher M. Morris, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of child endangerment in violation of Article 119b, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of child endangerment, one specification of assault, one specification of obstruction of justice, and one specification of animal abuse in violation of Articles 119b, 128, 131b, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1. The sentence was consistent with the terms of a plea agreement.

On 12 May 2021, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Riley, Kansas, PV2 Patrick A. Kenneh, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of making a false official statement and one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Articles 107 and 128, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeit \$1,320 pay per month for 5 months, to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 5 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge. The sentence was consistent with the terms of a plea agreement.

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
