SUBJECT: Heraldic Entitlements for the US Army Dental Health Activity, Fort Drum

1. As a result of the Dental Activity, Fort Drum, being discontinued by Headquarters, US Army Medical Command Permanent Orders 230-027, dated 17 August 2016, the distinctive unit insignia (DUI) has been cancelled as outlined in the enclosure.
2. The new designation as the US Army Dental Health Activity, Fort Drum is authorized by Headquarters, US Army Medical Command Permanent Orders 230-028, dated 17 August 2016. This unit has no lineal connection to the old DENTAC and is being established as a new unit. Therefore, a new DUI design is required.
3. Units have the option to include a motto in the DUI design. If a unit motto is desired, three mottoes should be submitted to this Institute for review. The mottoes are limited to 26 characters (letters and spaces), and should be submitted in order of preference. You also have the option to submit recommended DUI designs for consideration by our heraldic specialists.
4. The unit flag will change to reflect the new unit designation as "Dental Health Activity." To obtain the new flag from the US Army Tank Automotive and Armaments Command, complete DD Form 1348-6 online at www.heraldry.army.mil; citing TIOH Drawing No. 5-1-979 in the remarks section. POC is Ms. Franklin, DSN 444-2515 or COMM (215) 737-2515.
5. Upon receipt of your new flag, the former flag will need to be properly inventoried. Contact the US Army Center of Military History for disposition instructions by sending an email to: usarmy.mcnair.cmh.mbx.answers@mail.mil.

(c) This unit is discontinued, and no lineal connection exists between it and DENTAC, Fort
Drum (W07UAA). Serviceable historic unit property, such as unit flags/guidons bearing the
correct markings for the new unit, may be transferred. Unit historical files may be retained by
DENTAC, Fort Drum (W07UAA). Unserviceable unit property and files should be disposed of

(d) Military and civilian requirements and authorizations are transferred to DENTAC, Fort
Drum (W07UAA) on the FY17 TDA.

(e) If civilian personnel are affected by this order, Commander will coordinate with the
appropriate servicing civilian personnel support offices to complete labor obligations (if
applicable) and to effect any necessary changes in appropriate civilian personnel data and pay
systems to update civilian personnel and pay records.

(f) Coordination for transition of all assigned personnel, equipment, and unit functions to DENTAC, Fort Drum (W07UAA) will commence upon publication of this Permanent Order and complete NLT 30 days after the effective date listed on this order.

(g) Unit will ensure the proper closure of the unit's Property Book in accordance with MEDCOM SB 8-75-11 Chapter 5-20 Property Book Closeout Procedures.

(h) In accordance with Chapter 5 of AR 600-8-6, Personnel Accounting and Strength Reporting, a Personnel Asset Inventory will be conducted NLT 14 calendar days prior to unit reorganization.

(i) The Derivative UIC (W3ZSF0) will be discontinued and archived in the Defense Readiness Reporting System-Army (DRRS-A) NLT 30 days after the effective date of 30 September 2016. All personnel and equipment must be removed prior to discontinuance. Format: 740
