1. The distinctive unit insignia (DUI) redesignated effective 4 October 2011, for the U.S. Army Warrant Officer Career College with the symbolism updated, was **originally authorized** for the Warrant Officer Career Center by letter AAHS-IHS, The Institute of Heraldry, 4 September 2008.
2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A Gold color metal and enamel device 1 3/16 inches (3.02 cm) in height blazoned as follows: Brün, on a saltire Or between three mullets, two in chief and one in base, of the last, two cannons in saltire, muzzles upward, Or (Gold), charged with a stylized mine case Azure. CREST: From a wreath Or and Brün, a torch enflamed between a wreath of laurel all of the first; attached below the shield a Blue scroll inscribed "STRENGTH IN KNOWLEDGE" in Gold.

SYMBOLISM

Brown is the color traditionally associated with the Warrant Officer Corps. The cannons with the blue mine case allude to the Warrant Officer Corps' lineage in the Army Mine Planter Service as part of the Coast Artillery. The enflamed torch symbolizes enlightenment and dynamic learning. The three stars signify the three components of the Army that will gain intensive military guidance from the College – Regular Army, Army National Guard, and Army Reserve. The laurel wreath, adapted from the Warrant Officer collar insignia, represents victory and achievement.

1. The shoulder sleeve insignia redesignated effective 4 October 2011, for the U.S. Army Warrant Officer Career College with the symbolism updated, was **originally authorized** for the Warrant Officer Career Center by letter AAHS-IHS, The Institute of Heraldry, 4 September 2008.
2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a Brown shield shaped embroidered item blazoned as follows: Brün, two cannons in saltire Or, overall a torch enflamed of the last charged with a stylized mine case Azure, all between three mullets, two in chief and one in base Or; within a 1/8 inch (.32 cm) Yellow border. Overall dimensions are 3 1/4 inches (8.26 cm) in height and 2 1/2 inches (6.35 cm) in width.

SYMBOLISM

Brown is the color traditionally associated with the Warrant Officer Corps. The cannons with the blue mine case allude to the Warrant Officer Corps' lineage in the Army Mine Planter Service as part of the Coast Artillery. The enflamed torch symbolizes enlightenment and dynamic learning. The three stars signify the three components of the Army that will gain intensive military guidance from the College – Regular Army, Army National Guard, and Army Reserve.
