
MEMORANDUM FOR SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: General Officer Retirement – Major General Wayne W. Grigsby, Jr.,  
XXX-X (b) (6)

In accordance with Department of Defense Instruction 1320.04, dated January 3, 2014, I am notifying you that Major General Wayne W. Grigsby, Jr. will be retired in the grade of Brigadier General effective August 1, 2017.

On September 26, 2016, General Robert B. Abrams relieved Major General Grigsby of command of the 1st Infantry Division pending the outcome of the Department of the Army Inspector General allegation that Major General Grigsby engaged in an inappropriate relationship while serving as a Major General. The allegation was substantiated and the Department of Defense Inspector General concurred with the finding. The Vice Chief of Staff of the Army issued a memorandum of reprimand to Major General Grigsby based on the substantiated finding and subsequently filed it in his official file. I have reviewed this adverse information in making my determination that Major General Grigsby's highest grade served satisfactorily was Brigadier General.
