## C. PARTIAL STATEMENT OF EXISTING UNITED STATES LAWS

**9. FOR ALL ENLISTEES OR REENLISTEES:** Many laws, regulations, and military customs will govern my conduct and require me to do things a civilian does not have to do. The following statements are not promises or guarantees of any kind. They explain some of the present laws affecting the Armed Forces which I cannot change but which Congress can change at any time.

a. My enlistment is more than an employment agreement. As a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, I will be:

(1) Required to obey all lawful orders and perform all assigned duties.

(2) Subject to separation during or at the end of my enlistment. If my behavior fails to meet acceptable military standards, I may be discharged and given a certificate for less than honorable service, which may hurt my future job opportunities and my claim for veteran's benefits.

(3) Subject to the military justice system, which means, among other things, that I may be tried by military courts-martial.

(4) Required upon order to serve in combat or other hazardous situations.

(5) Entitled to receive pay, allowances, and other benefits as provided by law and regulation.

b. Laws and regulations that govern military personnel may change without notice to me. Such changes may affect my status, pay, allowances, benefits, and responsibilities as a member of the Armed Forces **REGARDLESS** of the provisions of this enlistment / reenlistment document.

c. In the event of war, my enlistment in the Armed Forces continues until six (6) months after the war ends, unless my enlistment is ended sooner by the President of the United States.

### **10. MILITARY SERVICE OBLIGATION FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE ACTIVE AND RESERVE COMPONENTS, INCLUDING THE NATIONAL GUARD.**

a. **FOR ALL ENLISTEES:** If this is my initial enlistment, I must serve a total of eight (8) years. Any part of that service not served on active duty must be served in a Reserve Component unless I am sooner discharged.

b. If I am a member of a Reserve Component of an Armed Force at the beginning of a period of war or national emergency declared by Congress, or if I become a member during that period, my military service may be extended without my consent until six (6) months after the end of that period of war.

c. As a member of a Reserve Component, in time of war or national emergency declared by the Congress, I may be required to serve on active duty (other than for training) for the entire period of the war or emergency and for six (6) months after its end.

d. As a member of the Ready Reserve I may be required to perform active duty or active duty for training without my consent (other than as provided in item 8 of this document) as follows:

(1) In time of national emergency declared by the President of the United States, I may be ordered to active duty (other than for training) for not more than 24 consecutive months.

(2) I may be ordered to active duty for 24 months, and my enlistment may be extended so I can complete 24 months of active duty, if:

(a) I am not assigned to, or participating satisfactorily in, a unit of the Ready Reserve; and

(b) I have not met my Reserve obligation; and

(c) I have not served on active duty for a total of 24 months.

(3) I may be ordered to perform additional active duty training for not more than 45 days if I have not fulfilled my military service obligation and fail in any year to perform the required training duty satisfactorily. If the failure occurs during the last year of my required membership in the Ready Reserve, my enlistment may be extended until I perform that additional duty, but not for more than six months.

(4) When determined by the President that it is necessary to support any operational mission, I may be ordered to active duty for not more than 90 days if I am a member of the Selected Reserve.

**11. FOR ENLISTEES / REENLISTEES IN THE NAVY, MARINE CORPS, OR COAST GUARD:** I understand that if I am serving on a naval vessel in foreign waters, and my enlistment expires, I will be returned to the United States for discharge as soon as possible consistent with my desires. However, if essential to the public interest, I understand that I may be retained on active duty until the vessel returns to the United States. If I am retained under these circumstances, I understand I will be discharged not later than 30 days after my return to the United States; and, that except in time of war, I will be entitled to an increase in basic pay of 25 percent from the date my enlistment expires to the date of my discharge.

**12. FOR ALL MALE APPLICANTS:** Completion of this form constitutes registration with the Selective Service System in accordance with the Military Selective Service Act. ## DATA REQUIRED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974

**AUTHORITY:** Title 10, USC, Sections 2005, 2101 through 2111, and 3013. Title 5, USC, Section 301.

**PRINCIPAL PURPOSE:** To specify the contractual agreements and obligations and to document your enrollment in the Army Senior Reserve Officers' Training Corps Scholarship Program.

**ROUTINE USES:** This form will be maintained in your Military Personnel Records Jacket and becomes a permanent part of your official personnel records as confirmation of enrollment, obligation and agreements.

**DISCLOSURE:** Disclosure of the information requested in this contract is voluntary. However, applicable portions must be completed if you desire to be enrolled in the Army ROTC Scholarship Program.

## PREAMBLE

This contract represents an agreement entered into between the United States Army and the Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) scholarship recipient (*cadet*) named herein, with the consent of the parent or guardian if the cadet is under the age of 18, to effect said cadet's participation in the Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps Program. It is hereby agreed by both parties, the United States Army and the Cadet, that the sole purpose of the ROTC scholarship program is to produce officers for the United States Army. Entry into this program is a serious commitment. This commitment must be made with the resolve to attain a commission. If there are any doubts about the prospective cadet's ability or determination to fulfill the terms of this contract, then this contract should not be executed. In consideration of the mutual benefits which will accrue to the parties hereto by reason of the cadet's participation in the Army ROTC and later service in the United States Army, the parties agree to the terms below.

## PART I - AGREEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP CADET ENROLLING IN THE SENIOR ROTC PROGRAM ADVANCED COURSE

1. As the ROTC scholarship cadet applicant named above, I hereby agree to do the following:
  - a. Enlist for a period of eight years in the U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) as a cadet for assignment to the USAR Control Group (ROTC) to become a member of the Army ROTC Program. This is a statutory obligation and will be accomplished by using DD Forms 4/1 through 4/2 (*Enlistment/Reenlistment Document - Armed Forces of the United States*) or DD Forms 1966/1 through 1966/4, as applicable; and if applicable, DA Form 4824, DA Form 3540/1 through 3540/4, or NGB Form 594-1. This Contract, which includes an eight-year military service obligation upon appointment as an Officer, and the Enlistment Contract constitute the required ROTC program agreements.
  - b. Enroll in the necessary courses and successfully complete, within the prescribed time, the requirements for the degree in the academic major stated above. I agree to remain enrolled in and successfully complete the ROTC program, including ROTC Advanced Camp and all training as prescribed by the Secretary of the Army or his/her designee, as a prerequisite for commissioning.

**PART I (Continued)**

c. Remain a full-time student at the educational institution named above until I receive my degree. A full-time student is defined as one being enrolled in sufficient academic courses to obtain sophomore, junior and senior academic status at the end of each appropriate one-academic-year increment of my scholarship duration. This includes the required Army ROTC classes which may be part of or in addition to those courses required for my degree.

d. Obtain prior written approval from the Professor of Military Science (PMS) if I desire to transfer to another institution. I understand that if I transfer to a school whose tuition cost is greater than the amount specified in Part II, paragraph 21a of this contract, I am personally liable for tuition costs in excess of the amount stated in this agreement. I may request transfer only to an ROTC host institution, extension center, or a designated cross-enrolled school. If I receive approval and transfer to another institution at which Army ROTC is offered, the provisions of this contract will remain in effect. Permission to transfer is contingent on my remaining academically aligned in Military Science (MS), i.e., MS II/SOPH, MS III/JR, MS IV/SR. Transfer to an institution that does not offer Army ROTC does not relieve me from the obligations of this contract. EXCEPTION: I understand if I am a nursing cadet, I may be required to transfer to a school to gain admission to an upper level program whose tuition cost exceeds the amount of Part II, paragraph 21a, of this contract. I further understand that the Army will pay the difference up to the maximum annual amount established by the U.S. Army Cadet Command.

e. Obtain prior written approval from the PMS if I desire to change my major. If I request and am granted written approval to change my major, and the change makes me ineligible to remain on scholarship status, I am not relieved of the terms of this contract and I will be required to fulfill the obligations under this contract.

f. Maintain, as a minimum, a cumulative academic grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 or equivalent scale. This grade point average must also be maintained for each semester or quarter. If I am required by my academic major or by the school I am attending to maintain a higher cumulative and semester or quarter grade point average, I agree to maintain that higher standard until the completion of the academic requirements for my degree.

g. Maintain at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 or equivalent scale, cumulative and semester or quarter academic grade point average in all ROTC courses.

h. Take and successfully complete as part of my professional military education one college undergraduate course in each of the following categories: written communication skills, human behavior, military history, computer literacy, and math reasoning from a designated listing of courses. The courses are to be taken during specified time phases of ROTC training and completed before graduation and commissioning, unless a written waiver is granted by the PMS.

i. Maintain eligibility for enrollment in ROTC, enlistment in the USAR, and commissioning, as defined by statute, Army regulation, and this contract, throughout the period of this contract except as hereinafter provided. I must meet the same requirements of the Army Weight Control Program and the Army Physical Fitness Test as are required of active duty soldiers prior to the end of the last school term of my Military Science III year. These then become continuous requirements, and I agree to take whatever measures are necessary to continue to meet those standards until the date that I am appointed as a commissioned officer. Commissioning eligibility standards, including the Army Physical Fitness Test and Army Weight Control Program standards, are subject to change, and I must keep myself informed of such changes through contact with the PMS.

j. Remain in a full-time active enrolled ROTC Scholarship status until the 45th day after the start of classes of each academic year as a requisite for the Army to be obligated for the cost of my tuition and any other fees under this contract. Flat rate payment for books and supplies will be payable in accordance with Part II of this contract. If I fail to remain in an active enrolled scholarship status until the 45th day, I will be in breach of this contract and I will be liable for the current costs of my tuition and any other fees due the institution, in addition to the consequences of breach of contract as specified in this contract. If the educational institution I am attending will not defer the payment of tuition and other fees until the 45th day after the start of classes, I may have to pay the tuition and fee myself in order to avoid having to pay a late fee. The Army is not obligated to pay any late fee I incur as a result of my failure to pay the costs of tuition and fees prior to the 45th day.

k. Obtain written permission from the PMS if I desire to extend the period of this contract or if I desire to take a leave of absence from the continuous performance of this contract. If permission is granted, I will be required to voluntarily extend my enlistment by an amount of time such leave of absence would extend beyond my eight-year statutory enlistment obligation.

l. If I am a nurse candidate, complete the baccalaureate nursing program and ROTC Training requirements by my projected commissioning date, and accept, if offered, a commission in the USAR, branch unassigned. Further, I will take the professional nurse licensing examination within 60 days following graduation. I understand I must pass the professional nurse licensing examination prior to attending OBC. If I fail my nurse licensing examination for the second time, I will be branched into the Medical Service Corps based on the needs of the Army in lieu of the Army Nurse Corps.

m. Undergo precommissioning drug and alcohol screening tests, normally administered during Advanced Camp training, or as may otherwise be prescribed by U.S. Army Cadet Command. If the result of any test is positive, I will be disenrolled from the program and I may be required to reimburse the United States for scholarship benefits received in accordance with the terms of this contract.

n. Undergo testing for HIV (*Human Immunodeficiency Virus*) during my precommissioning physical examination, normally during Advanced Camp training or as may otherwise be prescribed by U.S. Army Cadet Command. If the results of the testing are confirmed positive, I will be disenrolled from the ROTC program at the end of the current academic term.

2. I further understand that:

a. By executing this contract, I represent that I meet all eligibility criteria for enrollment in the ROTC Program and commissioning, as defined by statute, Army regulation and this contract. If I am ineligible for enrollment in ROTC or commissioning and such ineligibility may be waived, I must obtain an approved waiver before executing this contract.

b. If my scholarship benefits are temporarily inactivated by a leave of absence or administrative suspension, or terminated due to my failure to meet academic or military retention standards for scholarship cadets, as prescribed by law, Army regulation or this contract, I will not be relieved of my obligation to the U.S. Army and my obligations under this contract remain in effect.

c. My enrollment, continuation in, and completion of the ROTC Scholarship Program does not commit the Army to appoint me as an officer. Such continuance and appointment will be made at the discretion of the U.S. Army and in part, will depend upon my satisfactorily meeting the requirements for continuance and appointment as established by Federal law, Army regulation, and this contract. If I complete the ROTC course of instruction and am appointed as an officer, any concurrent enlisted service with a Reserve Component Unit while I am an ROTC Basic or Advanced Course cadet will not be credited in computing my entitlement to basic pay (37 U.S.C. 205(d)). Additionally, if I am appointed as an officer, I will not be credited with length of service for any purpose for the period of my membership in a Reserve Component Unit while I am a member of the ROTC Advanced Course (10 U.S.C. 2106(c)).

d. The U.S. Army cannot guarantee that my religious practices will be accommodated. I acknowledge and understand that it is Department of the Army policy to accommodate religious practices as long as the practice will not have an adverse impact on military readiness, unit cohesion, standards, health, safety or discipline. I further acknowledge and understand that the U.S. Army has the right to amend or eliminate any such accommodation based on the needs of the Army.

e. If I at any time apply for and receive conscientious objector status, I will be disenrolled from the program and I may be required to reimburse the United States for scholarship benefits received in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

f. Homosexual conduct is grounds for disenrollment. Homosexual conduct is a homosexual act, a statement by the member that demonstrates a propensity or intent to engage in homosexual acts, or a homosexual marriage or attempted marriage. A homosexual act means any bodily contact, actively undertaken or passively permitted, between members of the same sex for the purpose of satisfying sexual desires and any bodily contact that a reasonable person would understand to demonstrate a propensity or intent to engage in such an act.

I understand that I will be disenrolled from the ROTC program if after investigation by a duly appointed board of officers or investigating officer or if I waive my rights to said board, one or more of the following findings is made:

- (1) I have engaged in, have attempted to engage in, or have solicited another to engage in homosexual act or acts.
- (2) I have made a statement that demonstrates a propensity or intent to engage in homosexual acts.
- (3) I have married or attempted to marry a person of the same sex as myself.

As a scholarship cadet, if I am disenrolled for homosexual conduct, I may be required to reimburse the United States for scholarship benefits received in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

g. I understand and agree if I am a 3-, 4-, or 5-year scholarship recipient, that I may not voluntarily withdraw from the scholarship program without incurring an active duty and/or reimbursement obligation after the first day of MS II class (*sophomore year*), or after the first day of MS III class (*junior year*) if I am a two-year scholarship recipient. Further, I may not enlist in the Active Army, another military service, or in a military service academy while I am a contracted ROTC cadet unless I am properly released from my ROTC cadet status.

h. If I was discharged from the active Army to become a 2-, 3-, 4-year scholarship recipient, that I may not voluntarily withdraw from the scholarship program after the first day of class without incurring an active duty and reimbursement obligation under this contract. If I am a freshman in the basic course and I am disenrolled from the ROTC Program for any reason, I will be ordered to active duty for the time not served on my original active duty enlistment when I was separated to accept the ROTC scholarship. If I have less than one year remaining on my original active duty enlistment, I will be discharged. The service commitment for cadets in the program beyond the freshman year who are in breach of their contract is as stipulated in paragraph 8 of this contract. If this contract is terminated for personal hardship during year 2 or 3, I will be considered for return to active duty in my enlisted status, if at least one year remains on my original active duty enlistment contract and I am otherwise eligible for active duty.

3. Upon completion of all requirements for appointment, to include medical qualification, all prescribed military science courses, Advanced Camp and any other training that may be prescribed by the Secretary of the Army or his or her designee, I agree to, as prescribed by the Secretary of the Army:

a. Apply for and accept an appointment, if offered, as a commissioned officer in either the USAR or ARNGUS, in accordance with governing Army regulations. I understand that active duty service may include worldwide assignment or assignment to a branch which involves combat or exposure to nuclear, chemical, or biological weapons.

b. If I have requested conscientious objector status and my request is not approved, I must furnish an affidavit or other evidence establishing withdrawal of conscientious objection and accept an appointment, if offered, as a commissioned officer.

c. Accept an appointment, if offered, as a commissioned officer in either the USAR or ARNGUS and not resign such reserve appointment before completion of my eight-year contractual military service obligation.

d. Serve on active duty as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army as prescribed by relevant Army regulations based on the needs of the Army, followed by service in the Reserve Components until the remainder of my eight-year contractual military service obligation has been served. If granted scholarship benefits beyond four years, I am obligated to serve an additional period of active duty equivalent to any scholarship entitlements extended beyond four years, e.g., six months for each additional semester of financial assistance granted *(or four months for each additional quarter of financial assistance granted)*.

NOTE: If a cadet with prior service, I further understand that I will be required to serve any unexpired portion of my previous statutory enlistment obligation. The unexpired portion of my previous statutory enlistment obligation runs concurrently with my contractual military service obligation under this contract.

e. Serve a short period of active duty or active duty training if appointed in a Reserve Component. If I am not selected for extended active duty, I will complete an officer's basic course for branch qualification. This will be followed by service in a Reserve Component Unit (*ARNGUS or USAR*) which has Monthly Unit Training Assemblies and an annual training period of approximately two weeks until the remainder of my contractual military service obligation has been served.

f. If I am fulfilling my obligation through Reserve Component duty and an appropriate troop unit assignment is not available or becomes unavailable in either the U.S. Army Reserve or the Army National Guard of the United States, to participate as a member of the Individual Mobilization Augmentee (*IMA*) program by serving at least twelve (*12*) days, excluding travel time, on annual training each fiscal year as directed by the U.S. Army Reserve Personnel Center. If it is determined that neither an appropriate unit nor an IMA assignment is available, I agree to participate as a member of the Individual Ready Reserve (*IRR*) by serving up to twelve (*12*) days of training each fiscal year until such time as an appropriate unit or IMA assignment becomes available or until the expiration of my contractual military service obligation. I may be required to travel the distance specified in Army regulations to fulfill my contractual military service obligation.

4. I understand that I may apply for a Reserve Component appointment and request service on active duty or service with a Reserve Component Unit (*ARNGUS or USAR*) at my discretion. However, my selection for the appointment and service shall be determined according to the needs of the Army at the time that my requested appointment is considered. Further, specific career field choices and branch assignments cannot be guaranteed but will be made according to the needs of the Army no earlier than 12 months before commissioning.

5. If, after having completed all requirements for an appointment under this contract except for that of obtaining a baccalaureate degree, I am appointed under the Army Early Commissioning Program (*ECP*), I understand all of my scholarship benefits (*including my subsistence allowance*) will be terminated at the time of appointment. As an Early Commissionee or a cadet who has completed the ROTC course of instruction and who is not appointed, I understand and agree to:

a. Diligently continue the pursuit of my degree to completion as a full-time student under the rules as established by the school which I am attending, and to keep my PMS informed of my academic progress on a semester or quarter basis.

b. Complete my degree requirements as soon as possible, but definitely prior to the expiration of 36 calendar months *(or 24 calendar months if I completed the ROTC course of instruction but was not appointed)*.

c. Keep the PMS informed of my permanent mailing address, my local address and my phone number on a monthly basis. I also agree to advise him or her of my status as it may affect my qualification for continued military service or appointment or my ability to complete my degree requirements *(e.g., illness, financial)*.

d. If assigned to a *USAR or ARNGUS* unit, maintain Army physical fitness and weight standards in accordance with the standards for active duty members contained in Army regulations, and take the Army Physical Fitness Test with height/weight verification at least twice yearly until I graduate.

e. If not assigned to a USAR or ARNGUS unit, schedule with the PMS and participate in the ROTC Battalion's physical fitness training at least once each quarter. I will maintain Army physical fitness and weight standards according to the standards as described in paragraph 1i above and Army regulations, and arrange with the PMS to take the Army Physical Fitness Test with height/weight verification at least twice yearly until I graduate.

6. I understand and agree that if I apply for and am accepted by one of the U.S. Army Health Professions Scholarship programs or the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences School of Medicine, upon graduation I must be approved for release, and if approved I will be appointed 2LT, USAR branch unassigned and transferred to the USAR Control Group (OADO) for detail, assignment or reappointment, as appropriate, to the Medical Services Corps. The active duty contractual military service obligation under the ROTC scholarship contract remains in effect. It will be added to the active duty service obligation incurred as a result of attendance at one of the Health Professional schools. These service obligations will be served consecutively upon completion of the Health Professional Training. If I fail to complete Health Professional Training or after completion of that training do not serve the specified number of years on active duty required under my ROTC obligation, I am obligated to make repayment at the discretion of the U.S. Army by either enlisted service or monetary reimbursement of scholarship funds in accordance with the terms of this contract.

7. I understand and agree that if I am disenrolled from the ROTC program for--

a. Failing to complete the educational requirements specified in this agreement or other educational requirements for ROTC cadets as specified in Army Regulations, incorporated herein by reference;

b. Failing to comply with other terms and conditions of this contract;

c. Misconduct.

d. Other disenrollment criteria established now or in the future by Army regulations, incorporated herein by reference; or if I fail to accept a commission, if offered, the Secretary of the Army or his or her designee may order me to active duty as an enlisted soldier for a period of not more than four years or, in lieu of being ordered to active duty, may require me to reimburse the United States through repayment of an amount of money, plus interest, equal to the entire amount of financial assistance paid by the United States for my advanced education from the commencement of this contractual agreement to the date of my disenrollment or refusal to accept a commission. I understand that I may be deemed to have failed to comply with the terms and conditions of this contract (*breach of contract*) regardless of whether I knew that the failure violated the contract and regardless of whether the failure was the result of an act or omission on my part made with a specific intent to avoid responsibilities under the contract.

8. If I am called to active duty for breach of contract under the provisions of paragraph 7, above, I will be ordered to active duty for one of the periods listed below, based upon the year during which the breach occurs:

a. During MS II, 2 years;

b. During MS III, 3 years;

c. During MS IV, 4 years;

d. After completion of MS IV, 4 years if I was a 2, 3, or 4-year scholarship recipient;

e. Scholarship recipients who are granted extended scholarship benefits beyond 4 years incur an additional active duty service obligation equivalent to the length of the extended period of scholarship benefits.

f. Any unexpired portion of my enlistment obligation remaining after such active duty must be served in a Reserve Component.

PART I (Continued)

9. I understand that if I am disenrolled from the ROTC program for any reason or if I fail to accept a commission if offered I may, at the discretion of the Army, be directed, in lieu of being ordered to active duty as a private (E1) for a period as specified in paragraph 8 above, to reimburse the United States through repayment of an amount of money, plus interest, equal to the entire amount of financial assistance paid by the United States for my advanced education from the commencement of this contractual agreement to the date of my disenrollment.
10. I agree that if I am disenrolled from the ROTC Program for any reason or if I fail to accept a commission, if offered, any money I am determined to owe the United States that is not paid in a lump sum on the date it is due, shall bear interest at the rate equal to the highest rate being paid by the United States on securities having maturity dates of ninety days or less and shall accrue from the day that I am first notified of the amount I owe to the United States as reimbursement under this contract. I also agree that, if the debt is not paid in a lump sum, I will be required to pay it in monthly installments over a period not to exceed 36 months, in an installment payment amount of not less than \$50, unless otherwise approved by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service-Indianapolis Center (DFAS-I).
11. I understand that the cost of my education under this program is, for all purposes, a debt owed to the United States and entered into voluntarily on my part which, under the provisions of Subsection (d) of Section 2005, Title 10, United States Code, may not voluntarily be discharged by my declaration of bankruptcy if less than (5) years after the last day of the specified period of active duty.
12. I understand and agree that if I voluntarily or because of misconduct fail to begin or fail to complete any period of active duty or duty in a reserve status not on active duty that I have incurred under this contract whether as an officer or an enlisted soldier, I will be required to reimburse the United States an amount of money, plus interest, that is equal to or bears the same ratio to the total cost of the financial assistance provided to me by the United States as the unserved portion of such duty bears to the total period of such duty I was obligated to serve.
13. If I am disenrolled for the purpose of accepting an appointment to a United States service academy, other than the United States Military Academy (USMA) at West Point, I understand and agree that the reimbursement provisions of paragraphs 9 and 10 above will apply. If I am accepted to enter USMA, I will be transferred to West Point. My contractual military service obligation under the ROTC scholarship contract will be fulfilled upon completion of the USMA training concurrently with the service obligation incurred as a result of attendance at USMA. If I fail to complete the USMA training or after completion of academy training do not serve the specified number of years on active duty required under my ROTC obligation, I am obligated to make repayment by either enlisted Army service or monetary reimbursement of the scholarship funds at the discretion of the U.S. Army and in accordance with the terms of this contract.
14. If my ROTC scholarship contract is terminated for any reason, but I am qualified and am allowed to remain in the ROTC program as a nonscholarship cadet, I understand that I will not be required to reimburse the United States for any financial assistance I received provided that I successfully completed the ROTC program and all of the active duty and duty in a reserve status not on active duty for which I am obligated under the provisions of this scholarship contract.
15. I understand that either as an enlisted member or as a commissioned officer in the Reserve Component of the Army of the United States or upon my transfer or assignment thereto, I may be ordered to active duty without my consent in the event of a war, a national emergency declared by Congress or the President, an order of the President to active duty authorized by the President, and as otherwise authorized by law, such call to active duty could be for the duration of a war or any period of time authorized by law. I further understand, as a voluntarily obligated member of the Ready Reserve, that if I am not assigned to or am not participating satisfactorily in a unit of the Ready Reserve and have not served on active duty for a total of 24 months, I may be ordered to active duty without my consent by order of the President until my total service on active duty equals 4 months, the terms of my enlistment notwithstanding.
8. I understand that if I successfully complete all of the requirements for appointment and I meet all the physical, mental, moral, and proficiency standards required of a commissioned officer, but am not tendered an appointment, I will be completely discharged from all obligations I incurred under the provisions of this contract.

17. I understand that the Secretary of the Army or his/her designee may at any time release me without notice from the obligations under this contract and disenroll me from the ROTC Program without further benefits thereunder if, in the opinion of the Secretary of the Army or his or her designee, it is in the best interest of the Army.

18. I acknowledge that I have discussed the eligibility requirements pertaining to enrollment in ROTC, enlistment in the USAR or ARNGUS, and accepting a commission as an officer, with the PMS, and that I understand these requirements. I realize that these requirements may change in the future. I agree to keep myself apprised of all changes in requirements and to maintain my eligibility to participate in ROTC at all times in the future.

19. I acknowledge that I must establish an account with a U.S. financial institution for direct deposit of my ROTC entitlements listed in Part II of this contract within 30 days of the date shown in Block T. I understand that I need to execute with the PMS and an established financial institution the financial documentation that is required to allow my ROTC entitlements to be deposited directly into my account. This account can be a checking, savings, etc. I will be required to maintain such account as long as I remain in the ROTC program and receive ROTC entitlements. I agree to change U.S. financial institutions if required to satisfy this provision.

20. I understand the provisions in the contract contain the only binding promises by and to both parties.

21. In consideration of the above agreement to the terms of this ROTC scholarship contract, the Department of the Army agrees to --

a. Pay for a period of TWO academic years (*provided funds are appropriated by Congress*) the following:

(1) Tuition and educational fees up to an annual amount of 12,813.

(2) A FLAT RATE, established on an annual basis by the U.S. Army Cadet Command, for textbooks, equipment, and other classroom supplies. This will be payable on the first day of enrollment for all returning or previously enrolled cadets. The flat rate for new award winners will be paid promptly upon completion of the 45-day requirement or upon validation of the scholarship contract whichever is later. (*Any items the cadet believes are needed that would exceed this rate must be purchased with other than Army funds.*)

NOTE: Under the terms of this contract, the amount listed in items 21a(1) and (2) above, are considered financial assistance and will be included in the amount which must be reimbursed to the Government if repayment is required. Travel from the cadet's home of record to the school listed above is not included in the above items and will not be paid by the U.S. Army under this scholarship contract. Four-year, MJC, and Green to Gold scholarship recipients will be paid for travel from home of record to school to accept an appointment as a scholarship cadet and to enlist in the USAR Control Group (ROTC).

b. Make payments of scholarship tuition and fees only if the cadet is an actively enrolled scholarship student on the 45th day after the start of each academic year. Payments will be made for the beginning of the term or the date the student began the term, whichever is later, provided that this contract is consummated before the end of that term. The 45-day requirement will apply only to the first fall term of each academic year; it will not apply to the second semester nor to second or third quarters. However, cadets whose scholarships are activated on or after the 45th day are immediately eligible for payment of scholarship benefits.

c. Pay a subsistence allowance at the rate prescribed by law and implemented by the Department of Defense Military Pay and Allowance Entitlements Manual (DODPM) for satisfactory participation in the scholarship program under Title 37 U.S.C. Section 209 during the period of this contract. Entitlement is not to exceed:

(1) 50 months for a 5-year scholarship (or extended benefits under 4-year scholarship).

(2) 40 months for a 4-year scholarship.

(3) 30 months for a 3-year scholarship.

(4) 20 months for a 2-year scholarship.

d. Provide pay, at the rate prescribed by law for cadets of the United States Military Academy and implemented by the Department of the Defense Military Pay and Allowance Entitlements Manual (DODPM), for the period that the cadet is in attendance at the ROTC Advanced Camp.

NOTE: Subsistence allowance and pay are not considered in determining the total cost if repayment is necessary.

e. Delay the commencement of the obligated period of active duty, should the cadet be commissioned in the Reserve and the cadet's application for resident graduate or professional study be approved, until the completion of the delay authorized for the study.
