SUBJECT: Distinctive Badge for the 1st Maintenance Company

1. The distinctive badge authorized this date for the 1st Maintenance Company was:

a. Originally approved for the 1st Ordnance Company, 27 December 1928;

b. Redesignated for the 1st Ordnance Medium Maintenance Company and amended to revise the description, 21 April 1949;

c. Redesignated for the 1st Ordnance Company, 18 December 1953.

2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A gold color metal and enamel circular device 1 1/16 inches in diameter overall consisting of a white enamel disc bearing throughout a red enamel diagonal from upper left to lower right and with a gold lion rampant superimposed overall, all within a black enamel heraldic garter with gold buckle in base and inscribed at top "NON NOBIS SOLUM" (Not for Ourselves Alone) in gold letters.

SYMBOLISM

The bend is taken from the arms of Lorraine and the gold lion from the arms of Picardy. The present Ordnance colors are crimson piped with yellow. The former Ordnance colors were red and black. The garter is taken from the well-known device used in the Ordnance Department as a seal for a number of years.

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3. The distinctive badge will be worn as prescribed in AR 670-5.
4. This authorization letter will become a permanent file of the organization in accordance with File No. 2-05, AR 340-2 or File No. 228-08, Organizational History files, AR 340-18-2, as applicable.
5. This authorization is in accordance with paragraph 14-19a, AR 670-5.

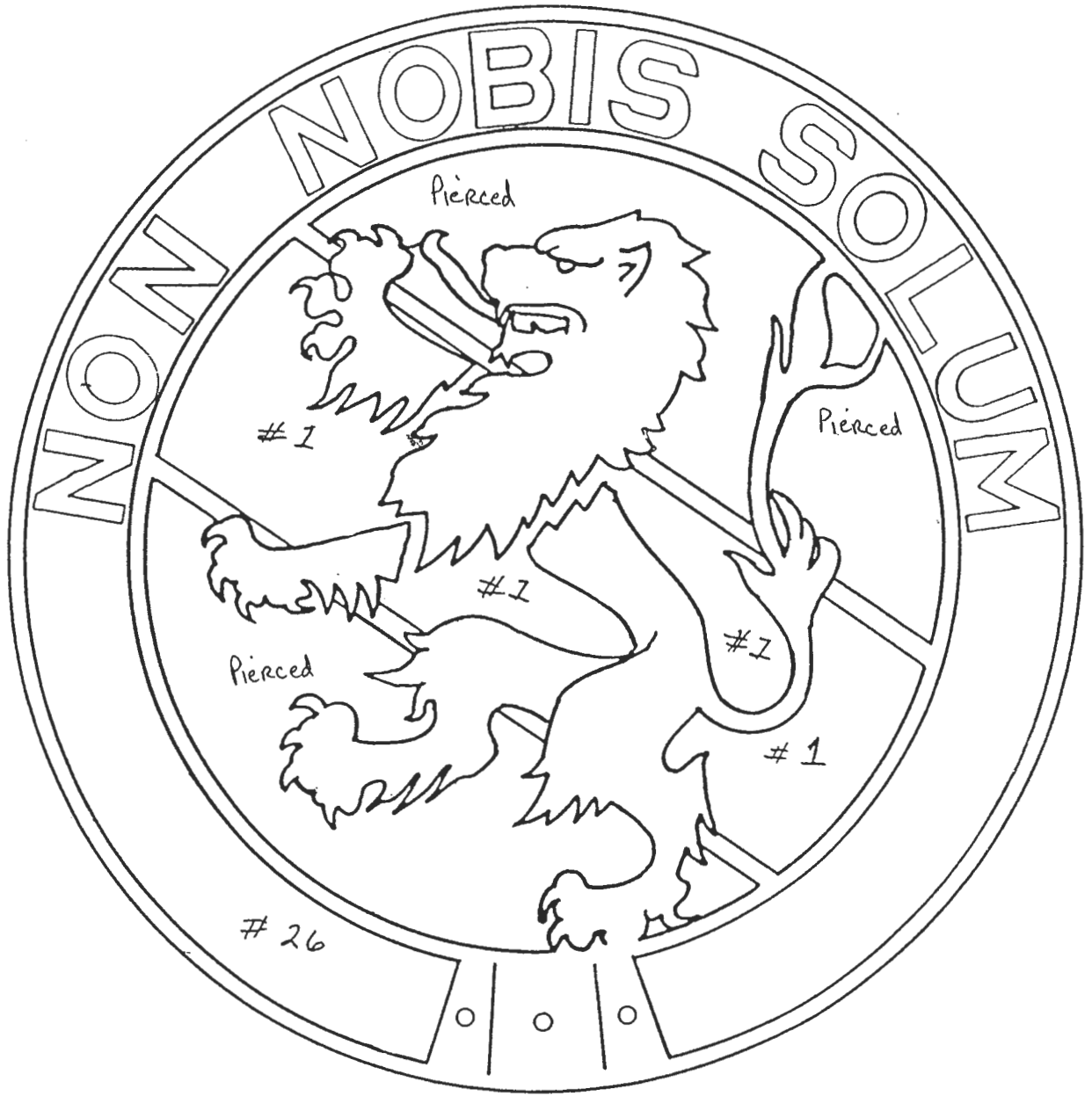
