SUBJECT: Coat of Arms and Distinctive Insignia for the 11th Medical Battalion

1. The coat of arms redesignated this date for the 11th Medical Battalion was originally approved for the 11th Airborne Medical Battalion by letter QMRRH 424.2 & 421.4 - 11th Abn Med Bn, Office of The Quartermaster General, 23 October 1953.

2. The blazonry and description are as follows:

BLAZONRY

SHIELD: Per pale argent and sanguine, two serpents addorsed and torqued the tails entwined, in chief a parachute all counterchanged of the field.

CREST: None.

MOTTO: Count on Us.

DESCRIPTION

Maroon and white are used for the Army Medical Corps. The shield is divided into two parts to symbolize the two theatres-- Pacific and European--in which the organization served during World War II and were awarded campaign honors.

4. The distinctive insignia redesignated this date for the 11th Medical Battalion was originally approved for the 11th Airborne Medical Battalion by letter QMGRH 424.2 & 421.4 - 11th Abn Med Bn, Office of The Quartermaster General, 23 October 1953.


5. The distinctive insignia (metal type for wear on the shoulder loops) consists of the shield and motto of the coat of arms for this organization which is described in paragraph 2.

TO BE WORN: As prescribed by current regulations.

6. Records of this Institute indicate the samples of distinctive insignia were approved for the 11th Airborne Medical Battalion by letter QMGRH 421.4 - 11th Abn Med Bn, Office of The Quartermaster General, 11 March 1955. The former manufacturer of the distinctive insignia is no longer certified for manufacture of military insignia. If manufacture of the insignia is contemplated, a painting and drawing of the insignia and a list of certified manufacturers will be forwarded to the Commanding Officer upon request. The painting and drawing can be furnished by the organization to any selected manufacturer shown on the list of certified manufacturers.

7. This redesignation is in accordance with the Statement of Service and Honors for the 11th Medical Battalion furnished this Institute by letter from the Office of the Chief of Military History dated 6 June 1963.

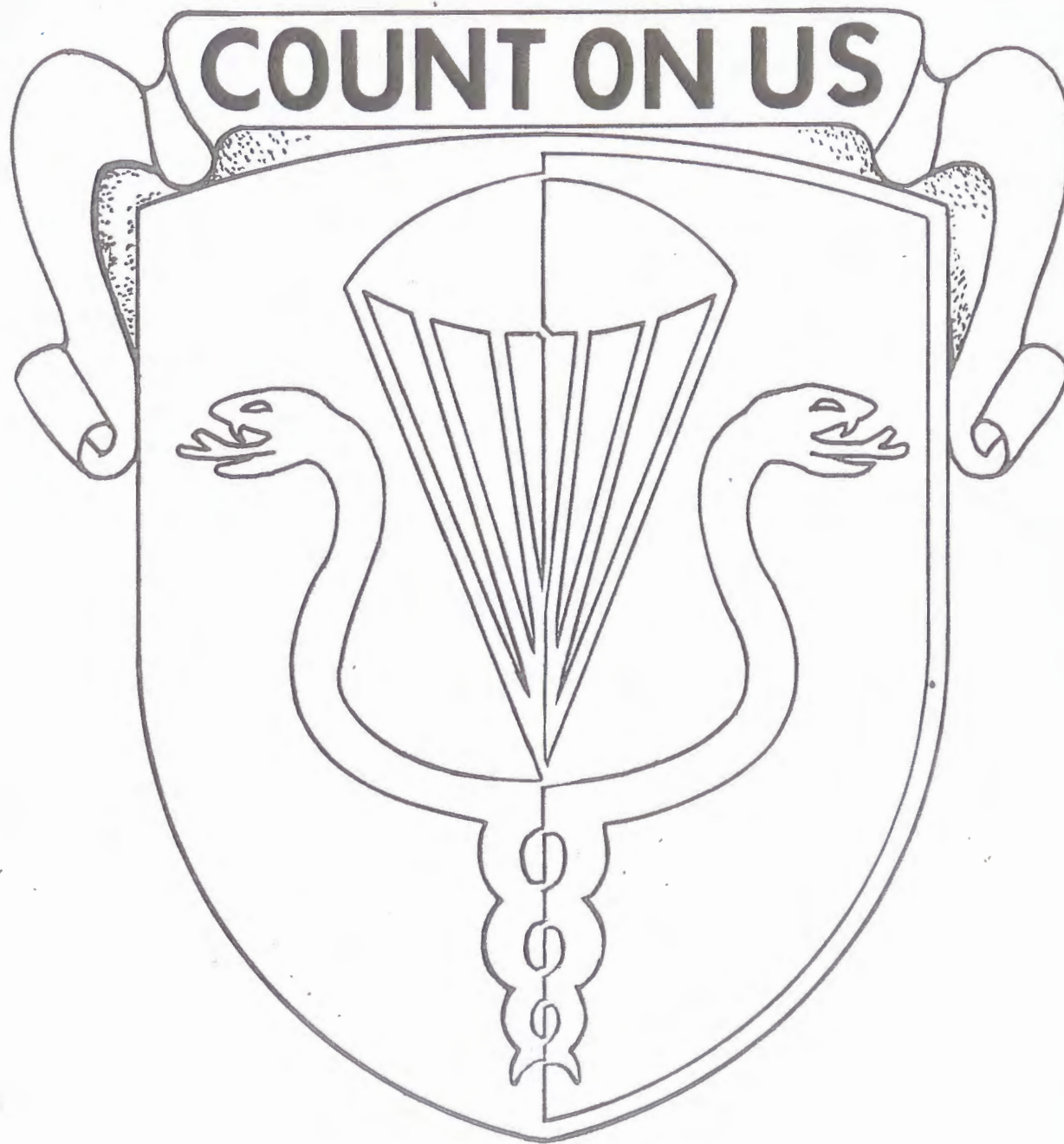
