1. The coat of arms for the 22nd Transportation Battalion is approved. The blazonry and description are as follows:

BLAZONRY

SHIELD: Per bend archy brick red and or, a bend archy parti of three azure, of the second and gules in base a columbine flower pendant slipped and leaved of the third.

CREST: None.

MOFFO: By Courage and Faith.

DESCRIPTION

Brick red and golden yellow are the colors for the Transportation Corps. The colors of the bend, blue, yellow, and scarlet, symbolize Infantry, Armor, and Artillery. They are used in reference to the battalion's mission of supporting these arms. The blue columbine, state flower of Colorado, refers to the battalion's activation in that state.
