SUBJECT: Coat of Arms for the 294th Infantry Regiment, Guam Army National Guard

1. The coat of arms for the 294th Infantry Regiment amended this date to correct the blazon of the crest, was **originally authorized** by letter TAPC-PDH-R, The Institute of Heraldry, 29 September 1993.

2. The blazon and symbolism of the design are as follows:

BLAZON

SHIELD: Azure, four bendlets wavy Argent, a Guamanian slingstone voided of the field, surmounted by a M-16A1 and a U.S. Navy 1917-pattern cutlass saltirewise point and muzzle up Or.

CREST: That for the regiments and separate battalions of the Guam Army National Guard: From a wreath Argent and Azure, a demi-sun Or bearing a stylized shield Gules, charged with a triton shell Proper, all superimposed by a triple-arch gateway of the Spanish Colonial Period, also Proper.

MOTTO: MASEHA NGAI'AN YAN MANU (Anywhere Anytime).

SYMBOLISM


SHIELD: The wavy field is emblematic of the Pacific Ocean, home area of the unit. The rifle represents the Infantry and combat readiness. The cutlass commemorates the beginnings of the Guam National Guard in 1917, as the Navy-sponsored Guam Militia. The slingstone is an established emblem of Guam. Red, white and blue represent Guam's colors.

CREST: The crest is that of the Guam Army National Guard.

SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the 294th Infantry, Guam
Army National Guard

1. A distinctive unit insignia is authorized for the 294th Infantry, Guam Army National Guard. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION


A gold color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches (2.86 cm) in height overall, consisting of a shield blazoned: Azure, four bendlets wavy Argent, a Guamanian slingstone voided of the field surmounted by a M-16A1 and a U.S. Navy 1917-pattern cutlass saltirewise point and muzzle up Or. Attached below the shield a blue scroll doubled and inscribed "MASEHA NGAI'AN YAN MANU" in gold.

SYMBOLISM

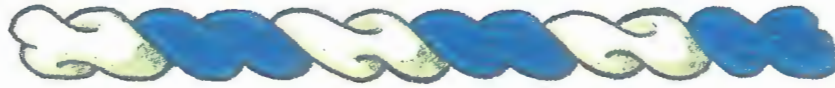
The wavy field is emblematic of the Pacific Ocean, home area of the unit. The rifle represents the Infantry and combat readiness. The cutlass commemorates the beginnings of the Guam National Guard in 1917, as the Navy-sponsored Guam Militia. The slingstone is an established emblem of Guam. Red, white, and blue represent Guam's colors.

2. This authorization is in accordance with paragraph 27-21, AR 670-1, and letter, NGB-ARO-F 310-49c, Organizational Authority Number 324-88, The National Guard Bureau, 20 November 1988.

3. This authorization letter will become a part of the permanent organizational history files of the organization in accordance with File No. 870-5a, AR 25-400-2.

294TH INFANTRY

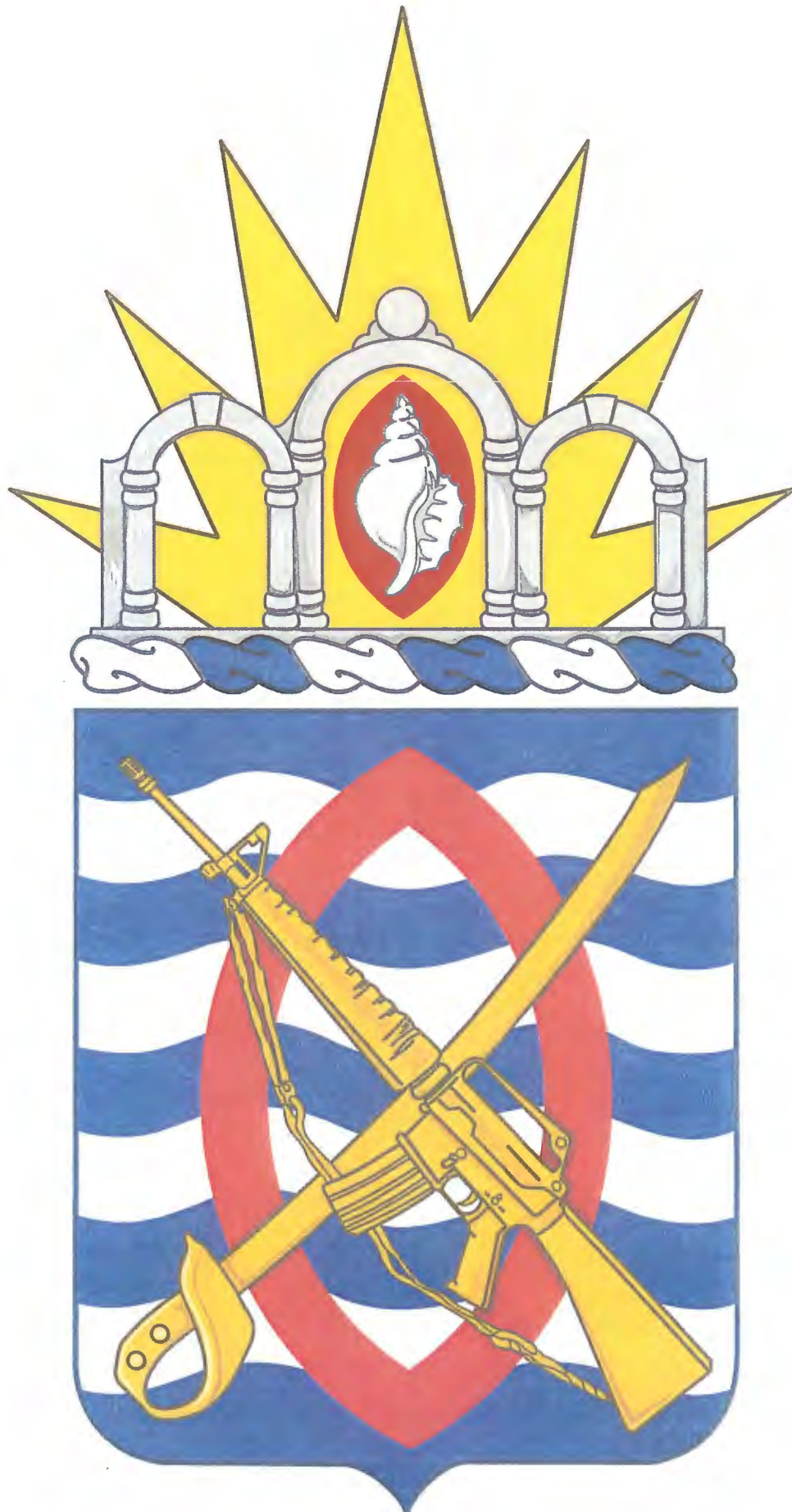

COLOR GUIDE SKETCH

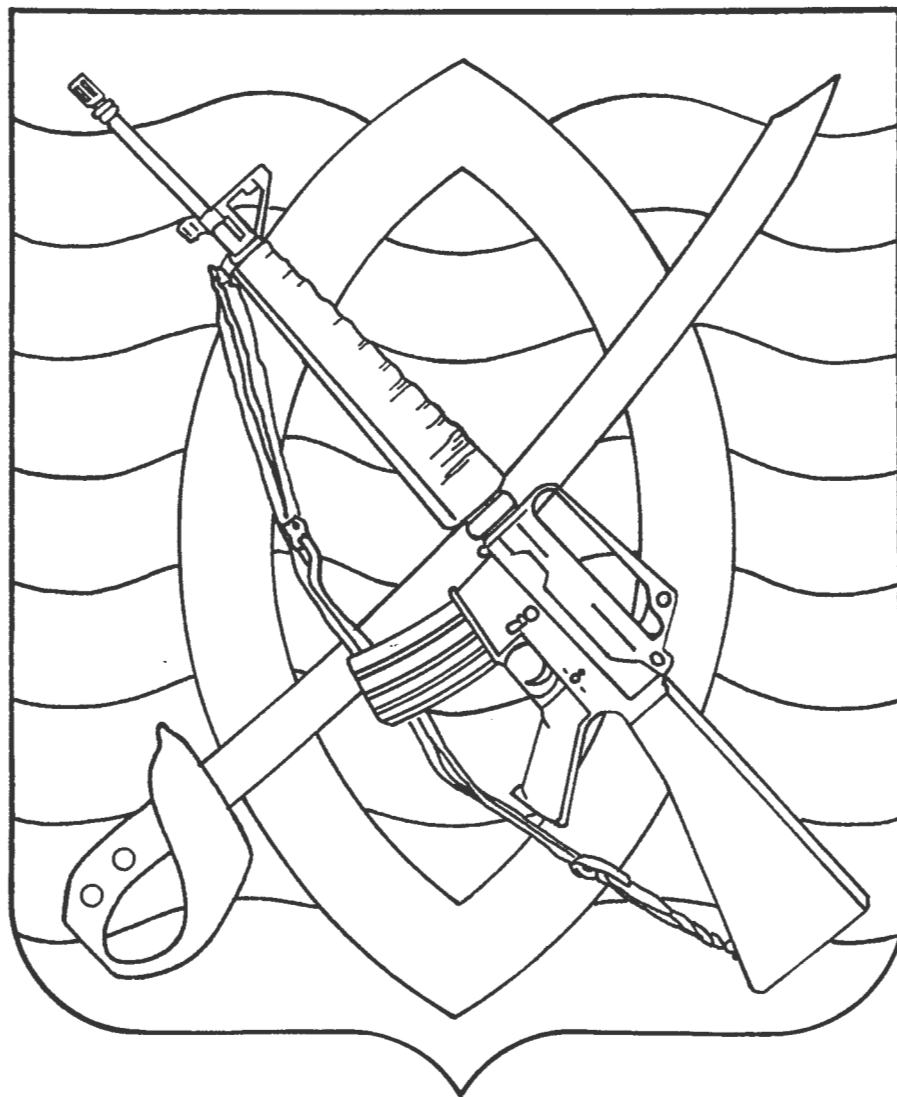

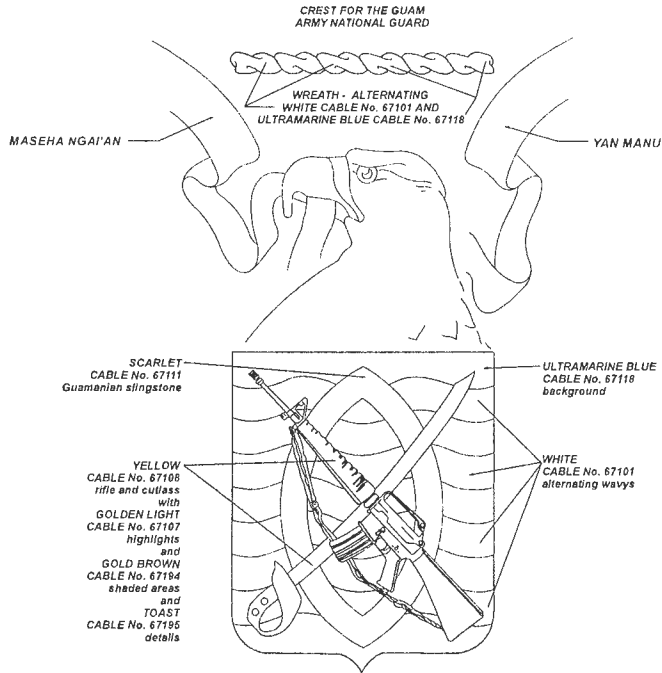
