SUBJECT: Coat of Arms for the , 365th Infantry Regiment.

TO: Commanding Officer , 365th Infantry Regiment, Camp Atterbury,  
Indiana.

1. By the authority delegated to The Quartermaster General by 2nd Indorsement, AG 421.7 Insignia (9-15-42) OB-I, The Adjutant General's Office, October 8, 1942, the coat of arms described below is approved under the provisions of Paragraph 5, AR 260-10, November 20, 1931 for the, 365th Infantry Regiment.

BLAZON

SHIELD: Azure, a fess argent between a fleur de lis and an annulet or.

CREST: None.

MOTTO: Fortiorum fortia facta (The brave deeds of brave men).

DESCRIPTION

The 365th Infantry Regiment (Rifle), was constituted on Regular Army inactive list as a component of the 92nd Division (AG 320.2 (4-30-42) MR-M-GN, dated May 5, 1942). This Regiment is to be made active 15, 1942.

There was a 365th Infantry Regiment in existence in World War I as a unit of the 92nd Division, American Expeditionary Forces, serving in the St. Die Sector (Lorraine), the Marbache Sector (Lorraine), and the Meuse-Argonne Offensive. Therefore, it is recommended that the World War I, 365th Infantry Regiment be

reconstituted and consolidated with the present 365th Infantry, which is to be made active October 15, 1942. When such action shall have been completed, the present 365th Infantry Regiment will be entitled to a streamer in the colors of the Victory Ribbon, embroidered:

Lorraine  
Meuse-Argonne.

The shield is blue for the infantry. The functions of the organization are illustrated by the silver horizontal band which is the heraldic representation of a Military shield or girdle of honor and signifies that the bearer must always be in readiness to undergo the business of public weal. The battle honors earned in France in World War I are indicated by the gold fleur de lis. The numerical designation is represented by the three divisions of the shield, the heraldic annulet, symbol of cadency of the sixth son and the annulet for the fifth son, thus forming the number 365.

SUBJECT: Distinctive Insignia for the , 365th Infantry Regiment.

TO: Commanding Officer, 365th Infantry Regiment, Camp Atterbury, Indiana.

1. By the authority delegated to The Quartermaster General by 2nd Indorsement, AG 421.7 Insignia (9-15-42), OB-I, The Adjutant General's Office, October 8, 1942, the distinctive insignia described below is approved under the provisions of Paragraph 51, AR 600-40, August 28, 1941 for the 365th Infantry Regiment.

The insignia consists of the shield and motto of the coat of arms of the 365th Infantry Regiment.

It will be manufactured in bright metal and enamel in one size as the organization may select, but not in excess of 1 1/4 inches in height.

TO BE WORN: As prescribed by current regulations.

2. It is requested that a manufacturer's drawing be submitted to this office for check prior to submitting manufacturer's sample in duplicate for approval and before supplying the organization with the finished product. It is suggested that the distinctive insignia be made approximately 1-1/16 inches in height.

SHIELD: Azure, a fess argent between a fleur de lis and an annulet or.

MOTTO: Fortiorum fortia facta (The brave deeds of brave men).

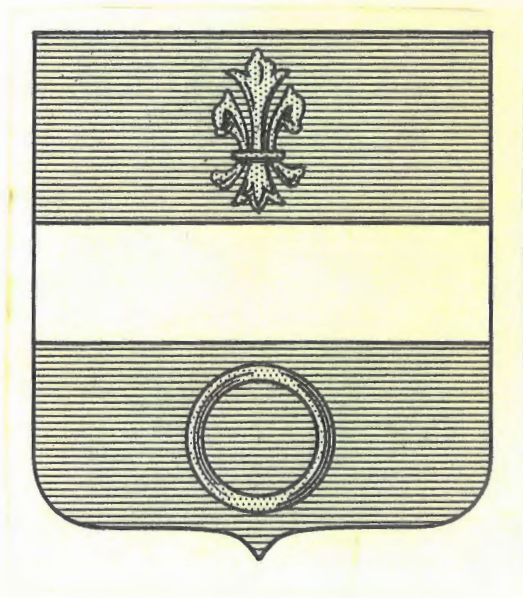

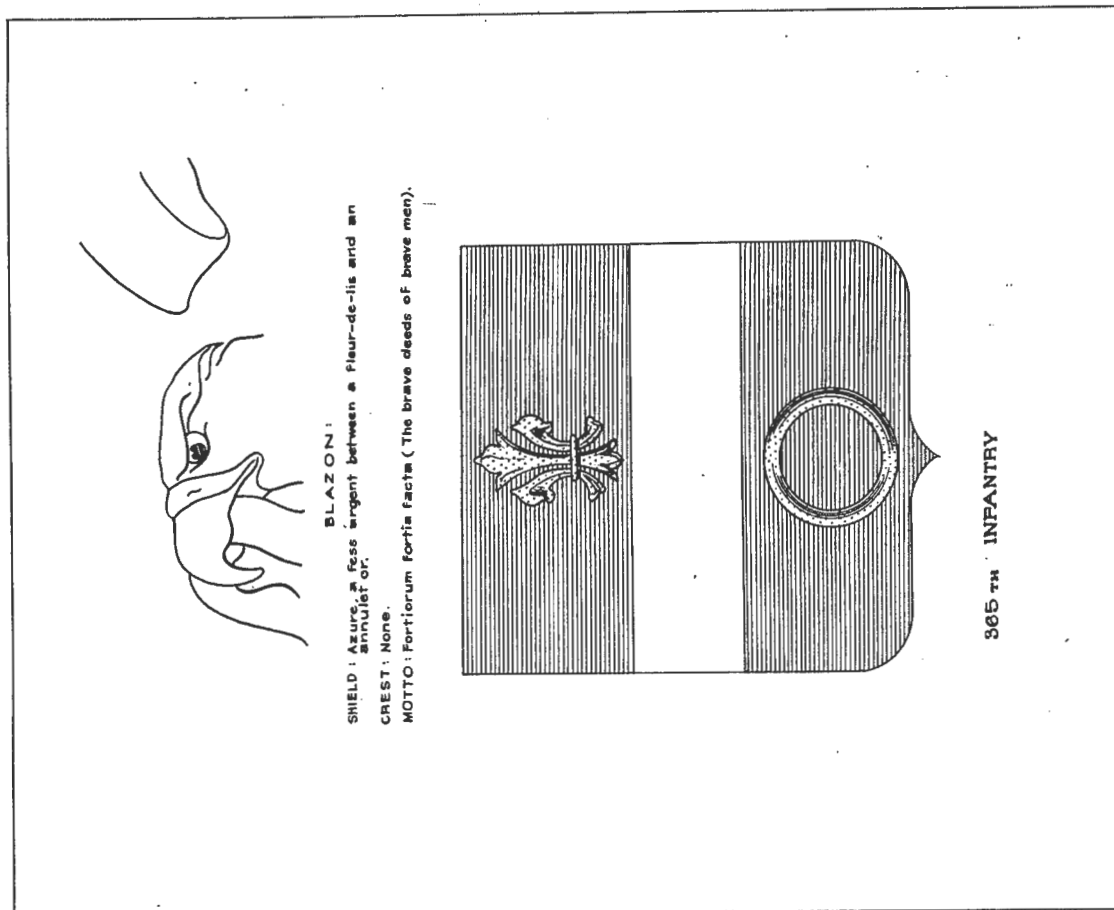


COAT OF ARMS FOR COLOR OF
