1. The distinctive insignia, redesignated this date for the 69th Engineer Company, was

a. Originally approved for the 69th Engineer Company (Topographic) by letter AG 421.7 - 69th Engr. Co. (11-7-41) LO, the Office of The Adjutant General, 7 November 1941;

b. Redesignated for the 69th Engineer Topographic Company, Corps by letter QMGRH 421.4 - 69th Engr Topo Co, Corps, the Office of The Quartermaster General, 31 August 1953.

The insignia is described as follows:

In front of a 45 degree red triangle bearing the motto "Cartas Celeriter" in silver letters, a silver transit head.

The insignia symbolizes the function of the organization. The colors scarlet and white (silver) are those of the Corps of Engineers.

TO BE WORN: As prescribed by current regulations.

2. Records of this Office disclose that samples of the distinctive insignia were approved by 1st Indorsement QMGRH 421.4 - 69th Engr. Topo. Co., the Office of The Quartermaster General, 19 May 1947. The insignia was manufactured by N. S. Meyer, Inc., 419 Fourth Avenue, New York 16, New York.



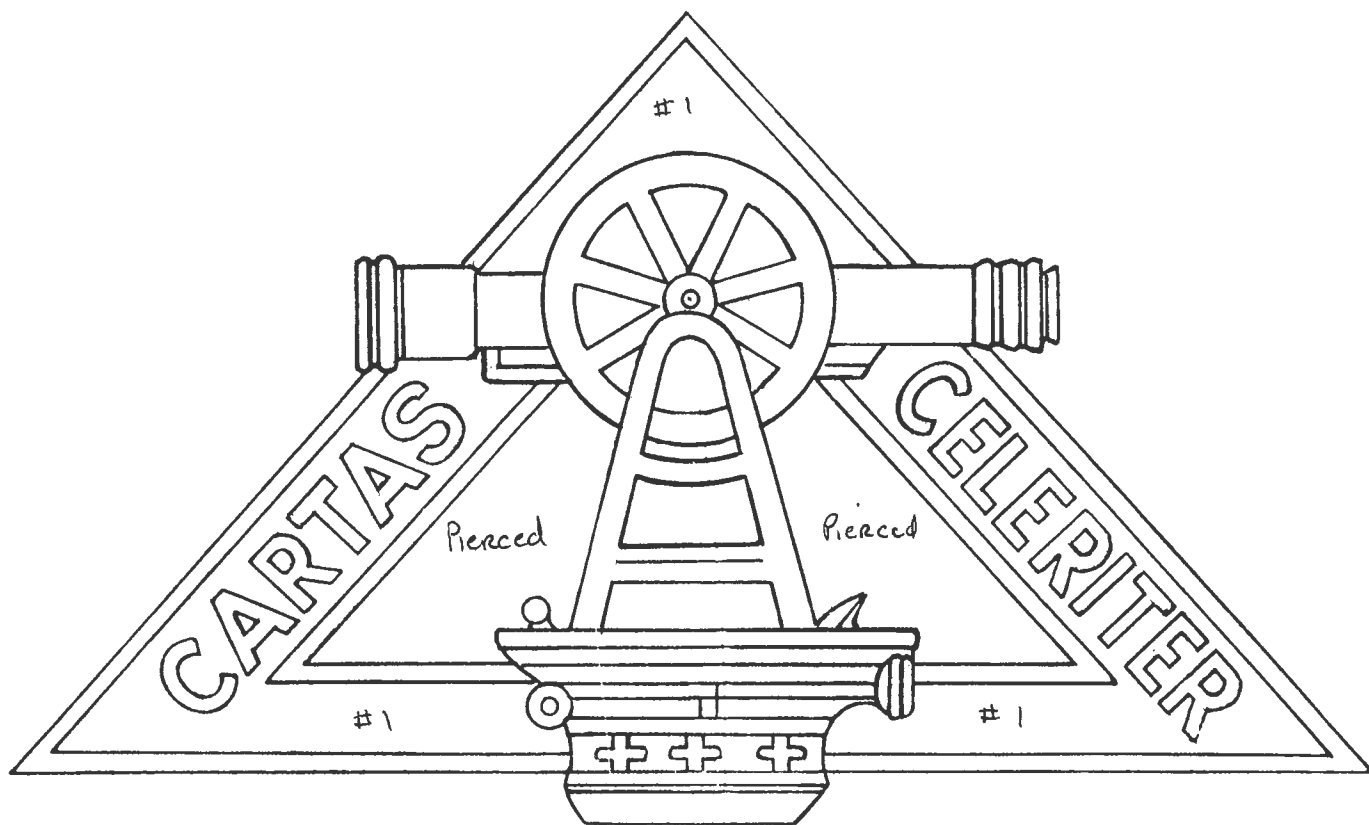

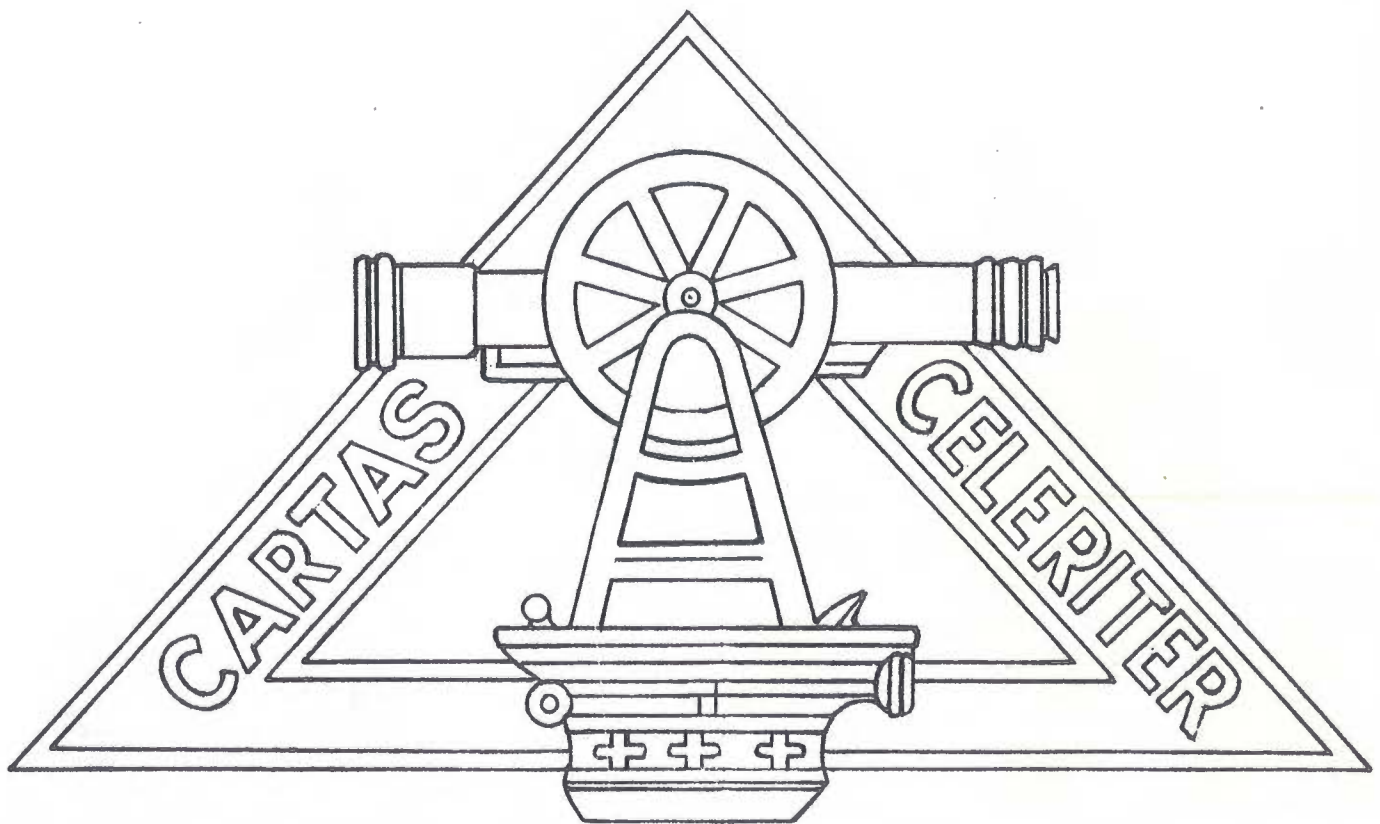
