
SUBJECT: Heraldic Items for the 920th Support Battalion

The color illustration and black and white line drawing of the coat of arms are at enclosures 3 and 4. An actual size color print of the approved DUI is at enclosure 5.

2. The DUI is a quality-controlled heraldic item and may not be procured until the development samples are approved by this Institute. #### BLAZON

**SHIELD:** Per fesse inverted Azure and Gules, a barrulet inverted Argent, overall a revolver Argent (Steel), muzzle upward to sinister, garnished Argent (Silver Gray), fimbriated of the third and a quill pen Sable, edged and detailed of the third, in saltire; on a chief wavy of the third a representation of a Government Bridge throughout of the fourth, garnished of the fifth.

**CREST:** None.

**MOTTO:** SERVIENS CIVIS MILITESQUE (Serving Citizens and Soldiers).

#### SYMBOLISM


**SHIELD:** Red, white and blue are the national colors, also adapted from the Army Materiel Command. The semicircular partition denotes Rock Island Arsenal in Illinois, the location of the Battalion. The Remington Model 1858 revolver illustrates the readiness of the contracting officers to force through harsh conditions to accomplish their mission. The quill signifies the unit's mission of contingency contracting and their commitment to remain as acquisition ready forces. The wavy chief upon the blue background alludes to the Mississippi River surrounding Rock Island Arsenal. The historic Government Bridge, built in 1896 under an Army contract, conveys the strong business relationship between the island and the surrounding Quad Cities community. The motto personifies the Soldiers' readiness to deploy in response to the Warfighter's contracting needs, always mindful of the trust bestowed upon contracting Soldiers by our citizens and the accountability due to them as taxpayers.

SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the 920th Support Battalion

1. A distinctive unit insignia is authorized effective this date for the 920th Support Battalion. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

#### DESCRIPTION

A Silver color metal and enamel device 1 1/4 inches (3.18 cm) in height overall blazoned as follows: Per fesse inverted Azure and Gules, overall a revolver Argent (Silver), muzzle upward to sinister and a quill pen Sable in saltire; on a chief wavy Argent, a representation of a Government Bridge throughout of the third. Attached below the device, a Black tripartite scroll doubled Silver inscribed "SERVIENS CIVIS MILITESQUE" in Silver.

#### SYMBOLISM

Red, white and blue are the national colors, also adapted from the Army Materiel Command. The semicircular partition denotes Rock Island Arsenal in Illinois, the location of the Battalion. The Remington Model 1858 revolver illustrates the readiness of the contracting officers to force through harsh conditions to accomplish their mission. The quill signifies the unit's mission of contingency contracting and their commitment to remain as acquisition ready forces. The wavy chief upon the blue background alludes to the Mississippi River surrounding Rock Island Arsenal. The historic Government Bridge, built in 1896 under an Army contract, conveys the strong business relationship between the island and the surrounding Quad Cities community. The motto translates to "Serving Citizens and Soldiers" and personifies the Soldiers' readiness to deploy in response to the Warfighter's contracting needs, always mindful of the trust bestowed upon contracting Soldiers by our citizens and the accountability due to them as taxpayers.
