
SUBJECT: Heraldic Items for the 925th Support Battalion

1. Forwarded for the organizational records of the 925th Support Battalion are the authorization letters for the coat of arms (COA) (encl 1) and distinctive unit insignia (DUI) (encl 2). The color illustration and black and white line drawing of the coat of arms are at enclosures 3 and 4. An actual size color print of the approved DUI is at enclosure 5.

2. The DUI is a quality-controlled heraldic item and may not be procured until the development samples are approved by this Institute. You will be notified when development has been completed, normally within 90 days. SHIELD: Per chevron abased Azure and Gules, issuant from point a stylized mountain range Argent, in base a pile Or (Buff), overall two swords in saltire of the second, points downward, superimposed upon the blades an unfurled scroll of the third, lined Sable, surmounted by a quill pen slightly tipped to sinister of the last.

CREST: None.

MOTTO: POTESTAS PER OPUS PROBUM (Power Through Good Business).

SYMBOLISM


SHIELD: Red, white and blue are the national colors. Buff is the color traditionally associated with Support units; combined with the chevron and pile, further emphasize support coordination. The stylized mountain range and swords allude to the unit's teamwork and its alignment with the 10th Mountain Division. The quill and unfurled scroll, adapted from the Army Contracting Command insignia, highlights the Battalion's affiliation, also signifying the unit's contracting responsibilities; to meet the Army's requirements. The motto personifies the organization's willingness to respond to the military contracting needs through sound business strategy.

SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the 925th Support Battalion

1. A distinctive unit insignia is authorized effective this date for the 925th Support Battalion. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:


DESCRIPTION

A Silver color metal and enamel device 1 3/16 inches (3.02 cm) in height overall blazoned as follows: Per chevron abased Azure and Gules, issuant from point a stylized mountain range Argent, in base a pile Or (Buff), overall two swords in saltire of the second, points downward, superimposed upon the blades, an unfurled scroll of the third, surmounted by a quill pen slightly tipped to sinister Sable. Attached below the device, a Black scroll inscribed "POTESTAS PER OPUS PROBUM" in Silver.

SYMBOLISM

Red, white and blue are the national colors. Buff is the color traditionally associated with Support units; combined with the chevron and pile, further emphasize support coordination. The stylized mountain range and swords allude to the unit's teamwork and its alignment with the 10th Mountain Division. The quill and unfurled scroll, adapted from the Army Contracting Command insignia, highlights the Battalion's affiliation, also signifying the unit's contracting responsibilities to meet the Army's requirements. The motto translates to "Power Through Good Business" and personifies the organization's willingness to respond to the military contracting needs through sound business strategy.

COLOR GUIDE SKETCH

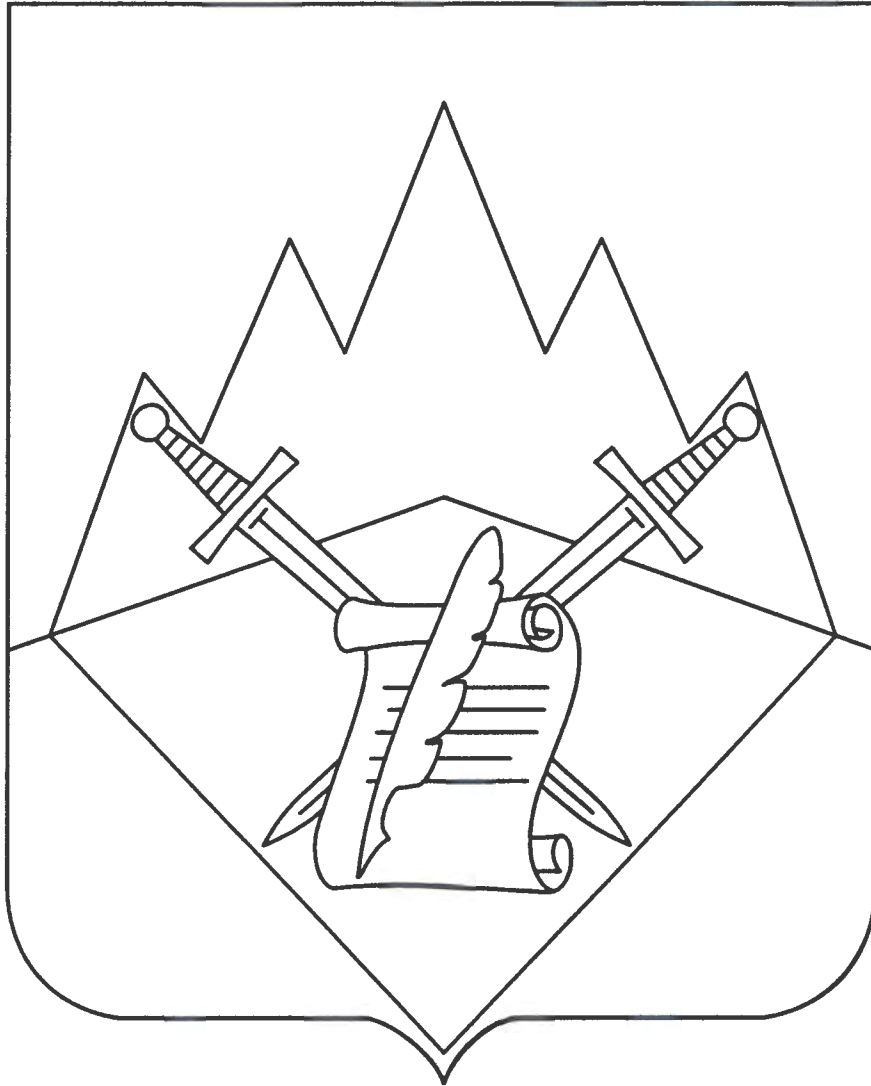
