SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the Hawaii Army National Guard (ARNG) Element, Joint Force Headquarters

1. The distinctive unit insignia (DUI) redesignated retroactive to 1 October 2003, for the Hawaii Army National Guard Element, Joint Force Headquarters and amended to update the description, was:

a. **Originally approved** for Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment and noncolor bearing units of the Hawaii Army National Guard by letter AGAH-A, The Institute of Heraldry, 1 March 1971.

b. **Redesignated** for Headquarters, State Area Command, Hawaii Army National Guard effective 1 October 1982, by letter DAPC-PDH-A, The Institute of Heraldry, 7 May 1987.

2. The description of the design is as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A gold color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches (2.86 cm) in height overall consisting of a white shield, bearing a gold and red delineation of the feather helmet of Kamehameha the Great in front of two spears crossed saltirewise in base, with a narrow light blue bar across the top bearing eight five-pointed stars arranged horizontally, all above a light blue scroll with the inscription "ONIPAA MAU LOA" in gold letters.

3. This authorization is in accordance with AR 670-1 and National Guard Bureau Organizational Authority Number 79-04, dated 26 March 2004. A copy of this letter will become part of your permanent organizational history files.

SUBJECT: Shoulder Sleeve Insignia for the Hawaii Army National Guard (ARNG) Element, Joint Force Headquarters

1. The shoulder sleeve insignia redesignated retroactive to 1 October 2003, for the Hawaii Army National Guard Element, Joint Force Headquarters, was:

a. **Originally approved** for Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, Hawaii National Guard by letter QMGHB 421.4, Office of the Quartermaster General, 14 March 1949.

b. **Redesignated** for the Headquarters, State Area Command, Hawaii Army National Guard with its description amended by letter DAAG-HDP-A, The Institute of Heraldry, 30 December 1983.


c. **Amended** to correct the dimensions by letter TAPC-PDH-H, The Institute of Heraldry, 29 September 1997.

2. The description of the design is as follows:

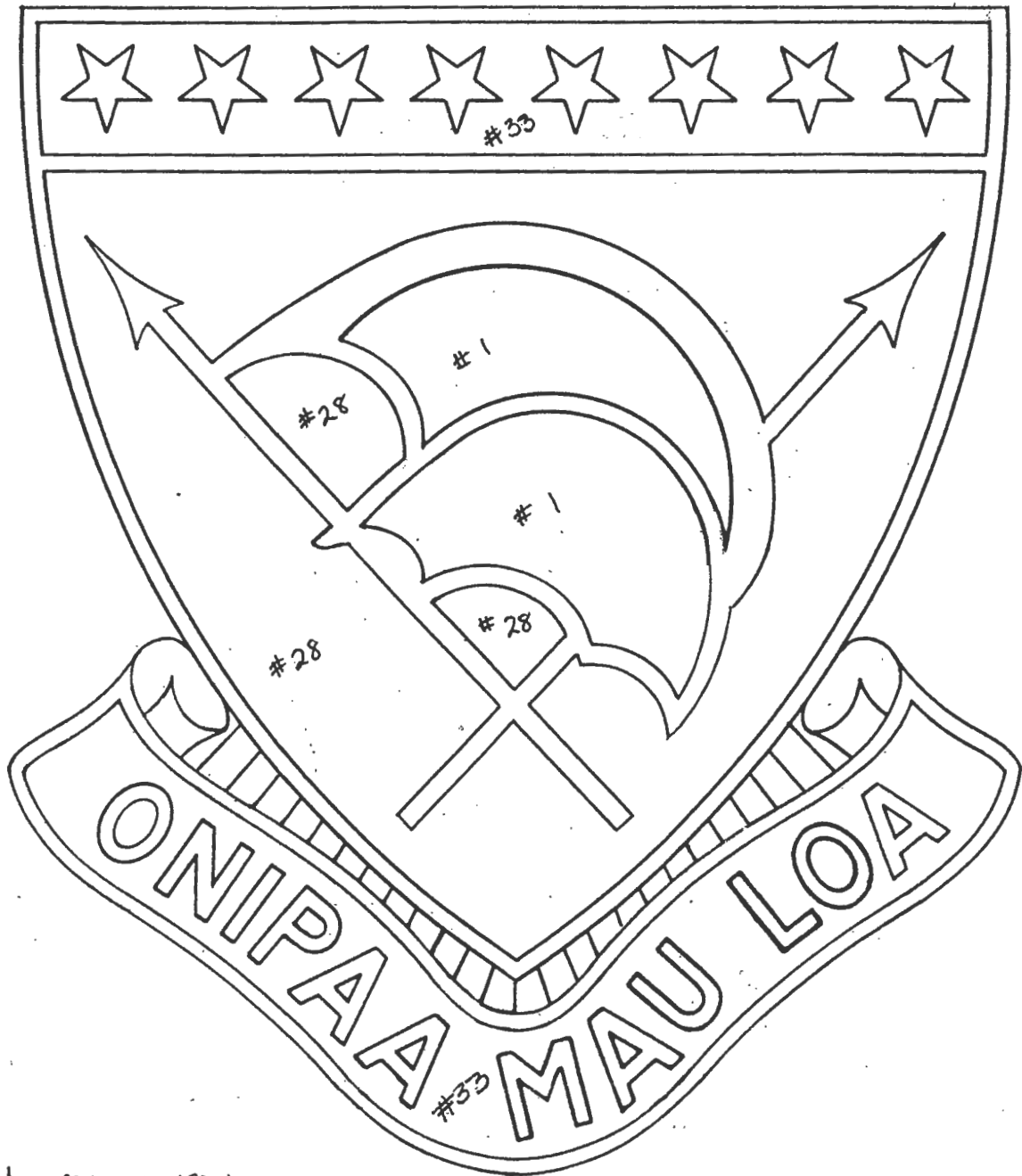
DESCRIPTION

On a gold disc, 2 7/8 inches (7.30 cm) in diameter overall within a 1/8 inch (.32 cm) green border, the head of Kamehameha I with his feathered helmet proper (face brown, helmet red).

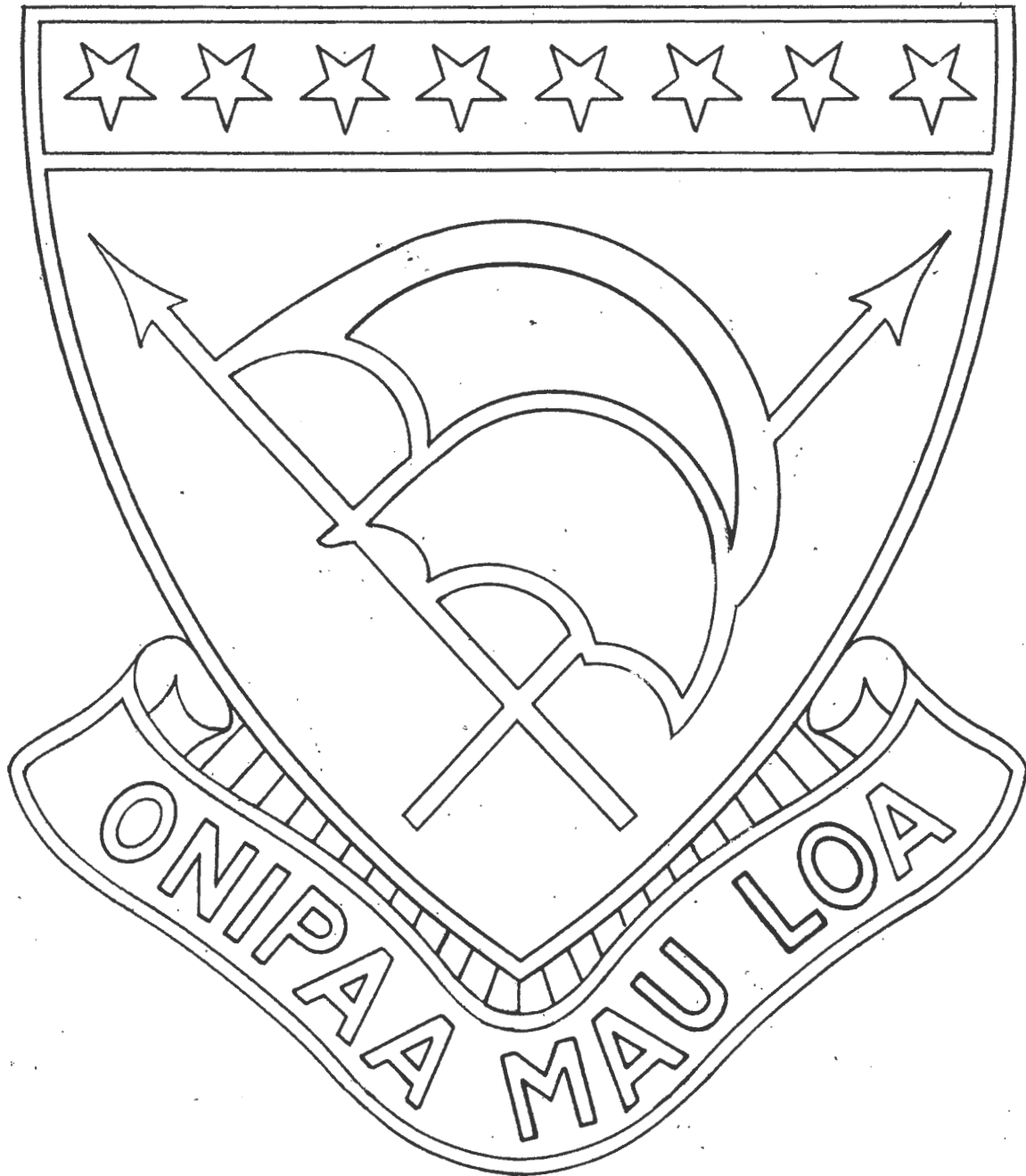

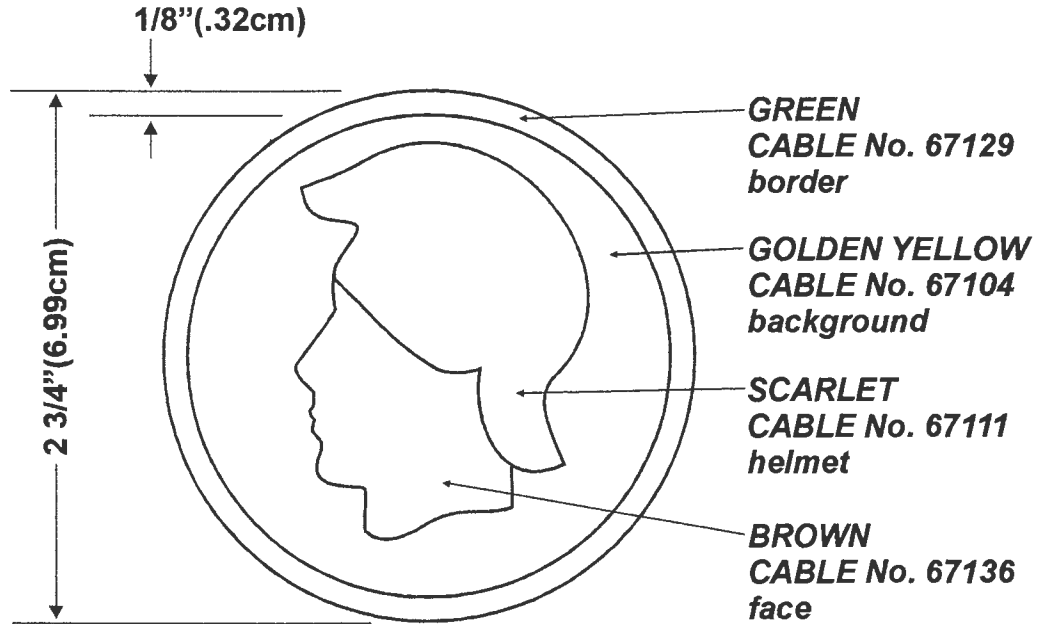
