1. A distinctive unit insignia is authorized effective this date for the U.S. Army Dental Health Activity, Fort Campbell. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a shield shaped silver metal and epoxied device 1 1/8" (2.86cm) in height blazoned as follows: Or, a bordure Sable surmounted by a pile enarched of the last, bearing a stylized representation of the 101st Airborne screeching eagle Argent (Silver Gray). Attached below the shield, a tri-parted Maroon scroll inscribed with "**BITE OF THE EAGLE**" in Silver.

SYMBOLISM

The border and enarched pile resemble an open beak of an eagle. This alludes to the motto of "BITE OF THE EAGLE" and recalls the screeching eagle of the 101st Airborne division, whose home is at Fort Campbell. Maroon and white are the traditional colors of the Army Medical Department. Silver metal denotes precision and sterility

2. This authorization is in accordance with AR 670-1 and Headquarters, U.S. Army Medical Command Permanent Order 230-024, dated 17 August 2016. A copy of this letter will become part of your permanent organizational history files.

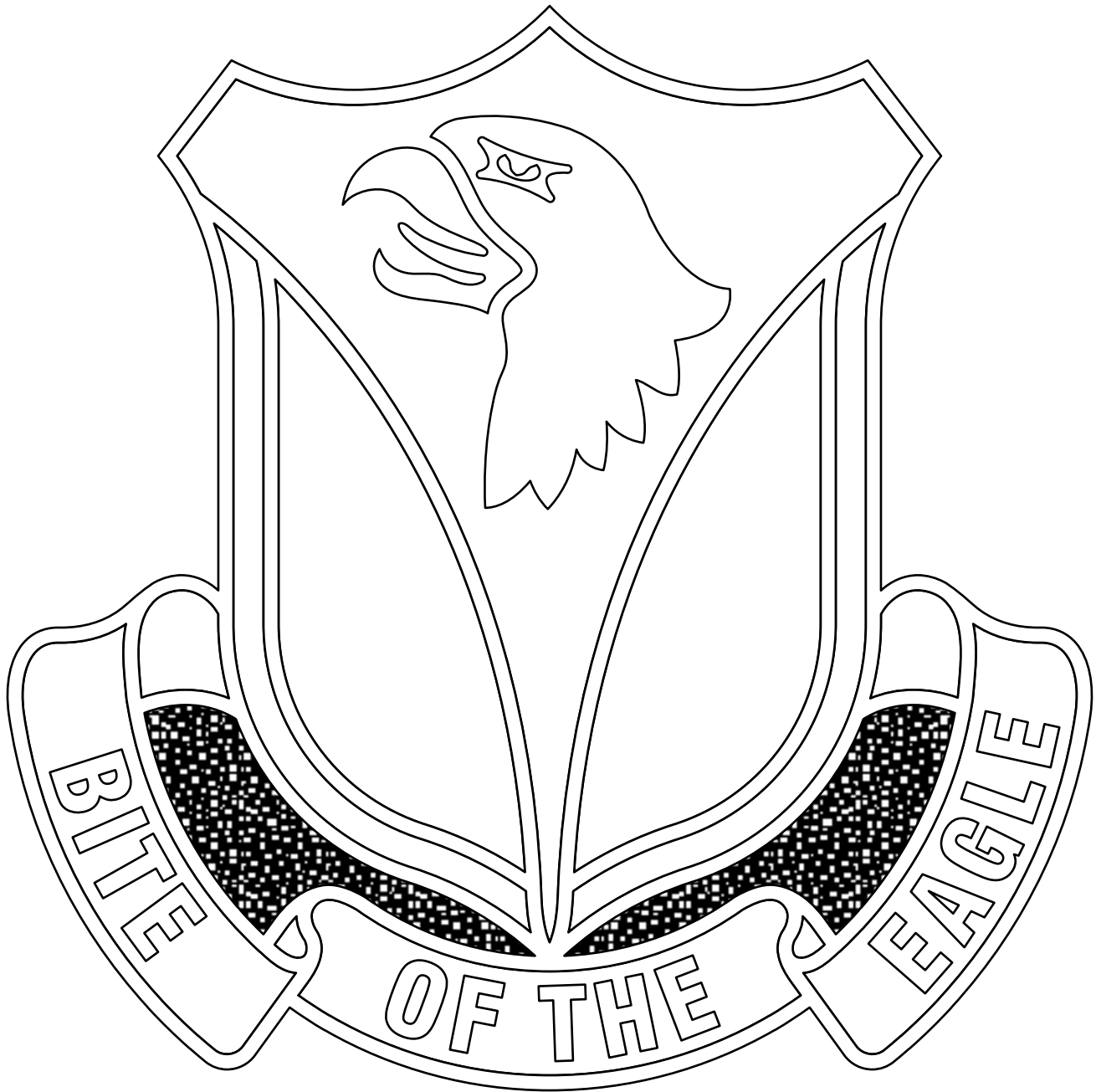

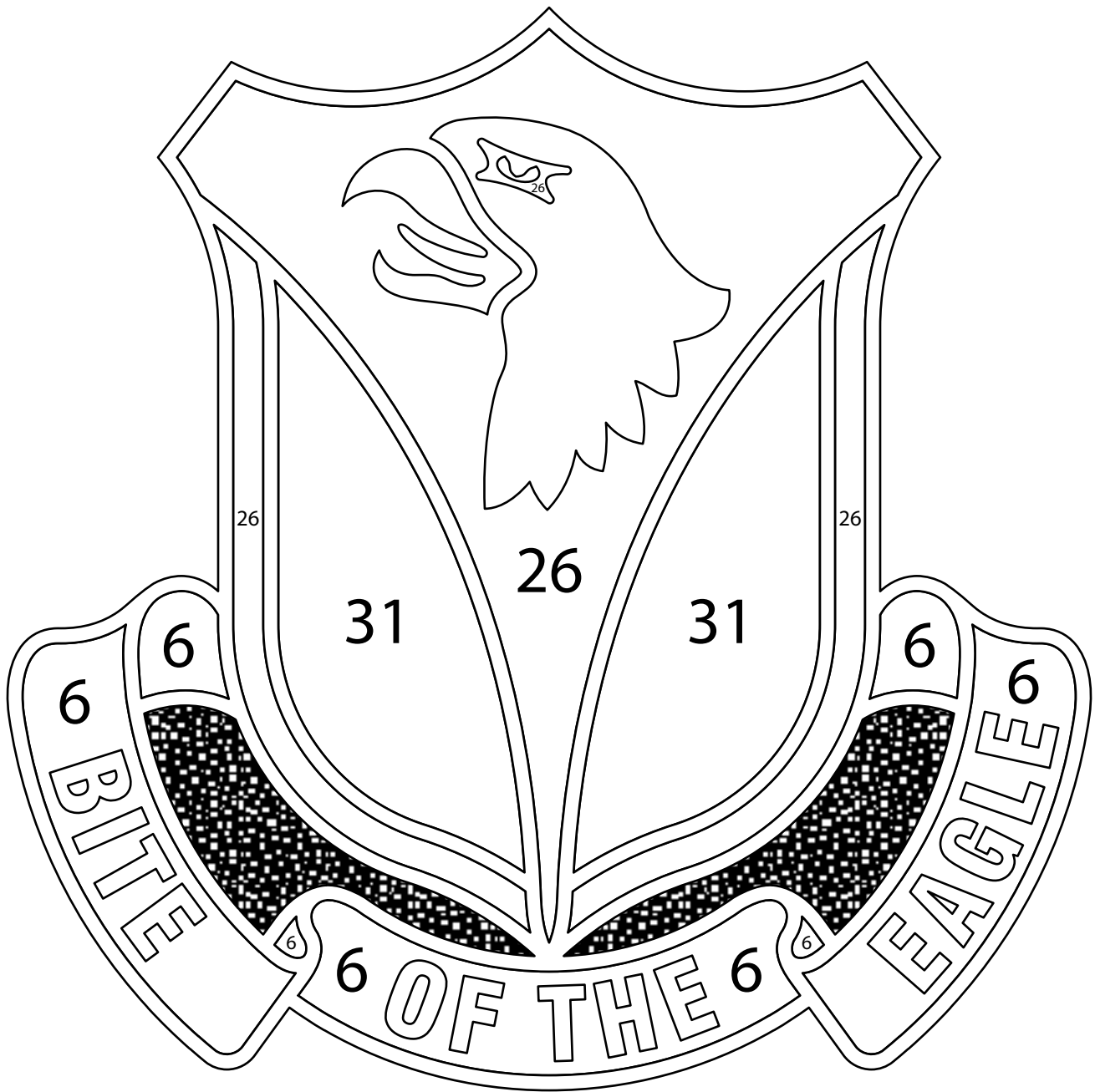
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
