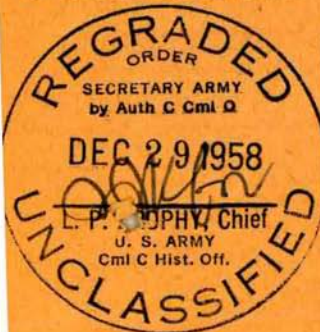

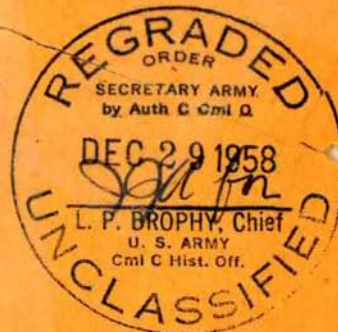

COMMENTS

"1. Mobilization Division, ASF, (Capt Cohn) called covering the disposition of the following Chemical Warfare Units:

The 169th Cml Smoke Generator Co., Edgewood, Maryland will be moved on or about 10 July 1944 to Camp Sibert, Alabama to be reorganized into a Cml Processing Co. This is a white unit.

The 72nd, 77th, 174th, and 176th Cml Smoke Generator Co., Edgewood, Maryland will be moved on or about 10 July 1944, disbanded and converted into Engineer Dump Truck Company. These are colored units.

2. One additional Hq. & Hq. Detachment Cml Smoke Generator Bn is to be added to the Troop Basis and activated in the very near future. This will be a white unit.

3. Due to redeployment of Cml Smoke Generator Companies the troop basis will show twenty six (26) Cml Smoke Generator Co's. authorized instead of twenty three (23) as at present."

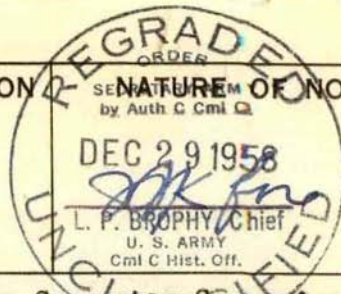

"1. The 75th, 76th and 77th Chemical Smoke Generator Companies are constituted and will be activated at the earliest practicable date by the Commanding General, Western Defense Command, at a station to be designated by him.

COMMENTS

2. These companies will be activated with colored enlisted personnel and organized under Table of Organization 3-267, with an authorized strength of 4 officers and 196 enlisted men each.

3. Stations and dates of activation will be reported to this office without delay.

4. Cadres will be furnished from the Chemical Warfare Replacement Training Center, Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland, and fillers will be furnished by normal requisition procedure.

5. These companies, upon activation, will be attached to the Fourth Army."
