SUBJECT: Insignia for Lillie B. Williamson High School, JROTC

1. In accordance with the approved suggested designs and with the provisions of paragraph 7-12, AR 145-2, the following insignia is authorized for Lillie B. Williamson High School:

a. Shoulder sleeve insignia (SSI) with description and symbolism as follows:

**DESCRIPTION**

On a yellow vertical rectangular-shaped embroidered item arched convexly at the top and bottom, edged with a 1/8 inch (.32cm) black border, a yellow stylized lion head roaring, eyes, teeth, and highlights white, its tongue, nose, and shadows golden orange. Attached above the rectangle, a yellow scroll edged with a 1/8 inch (3.2 cm) black border inscribed "**L. B. WILLIAMSON**" in black letters. Attached below the rectangle, a yellow scroll edged with a 1/8 inch black border inscribed "**LIONS PRIDE**" in black letters. The overall dimensions are 3 1/2 inches (8.89 cm) in height and 2 1/2 inches (6.35 cm) in width.

**SYMBOLISM**

Black and gold are the school colors and white suggests unity. The lion is the school's mascot and it roars with motivation to take action. The lion's pride further signifies cooperation and teamwork.

b. Shoulder loop insignia (SLI) with description and symbolism as follows:

SUBJECT: Insignia for Lillie B. Williamson High School, JROTC

### **DESCRIPTION**

On a shield shaped gold metal and epoxied device 1 1/4 inches (3.18 cm) in height blazoned as follows: Quarterly Sable and Argent, in first quarter a torch enflamed, between two laurel branches Or; in the second quarter a lion salient of the last; in the third quarter a winged foot bendwise Or; and in the fourth quarter a book slightly opened bend sinisterwise of the last, pages Argent. Attached below the shield, a Black scroll, inscribed **“INTEGRITY • SERVICE • CITIZENSHIP”** in Gold letters.

### **SYMBOLISM**

Black and gold are the school colors and white suggests unity. The torch between laurel branches denotes the ability to lead and serve as a guiding light for others. The lion heraldically stands in salient form, ready and motivated to take action. The lion's pride further signifies cooperation and teamwork. The winged foot alludes to strength and excellence in athletics. The book suggests knowledge and academic achievements.
