

## **Summarized Report of Results of Trial**

### **First Judicial Circuit**

On 05 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Lee, Virginia, a Staff Sergeant, was acquitted by a military judge of one specification of attempted sexual abuse of a child, one specification of sexual assault of a child, and one specification of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Articles 80, and 120b, UCMJ.

On 06 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at West Point, New York, a Cadet, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officer members of five specifications of sexual abuse of a child, three specifications of assault consummated by a battery upon a child, and one specification of providing alcoholic beverages to a minor, in violation of Articles 120b, 128, and 134, UCMJ.

On 07 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, SSG Michael D. Carter, United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his plea, of one specification of indecent exposure, in violation of Article 120c, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of attempted abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 80, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-4, and to forfeit \$1,776.00 pay per month for 1 month.

On 11 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, PFC Michael D. Johnson, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of sexual abuse of a child, one specification of possessing child pornography, one specification of producing child pornography, and one specification of distributing child pornography, in violation of Articles 120b, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 1 year, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 12 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, PVT Devyn K. Tyler, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of sexual assault, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 12 months, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 13 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, SFC Christopher R. Stine, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of three specifications of absence without leave, two specifications of failure to report, one specification of willfully disobeying a commissioned officer, two specifications of false official statement, one specification of selling military property, one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, one specification of larceny, one specification of housebreaking, and one specification of false swearing, in violation of Article 86, 90, 107, 108, 112a, 121, 130, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge

sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-4, and to be confined for 180 days.

On 24 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, SGT Christian J. Burroughs, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of false official statement, one specification of conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline, one specification of obstructing justice, and four specifications of reckless endangerment, in violation of Articles 107 and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit \$500.00 pay per month for 4 months, and to be confined for 4 months.

### **Second Judicial Circuit**

On 03 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, SGT Clayton A. Blough, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of maltreatment, and one specification of assault, in violation of Articles 93, and 128, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-3, and to be confined for 30 days.

On 04 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Stewart, Georgia, PVT William C. Polk, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of absence without leave terminated by apprehension, one specification of absence without leave, and one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, in violation of Articles 86, and 112a, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 6 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 18 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, SPC Houbenove Pierre-Louis, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of larceny, in violation of Article 121, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 30 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 26 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, SSG Willie J. Penton III, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 60 days.

On 27 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Benning, Georgia, PVT Malcolm T. Ervin, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of absence without leave, one specification of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, one specification of false official statement, and two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Articles 86, 90, 107, and

120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 7 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 29 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Stewart, Georgia, PVT Michael T. Bradley, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of violating a lawful order, one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, and three specifications of wrongful possession of a controlled substance, in violation of Articles 92, and 112a, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 10 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

### **Third Judicial Circuit**

On 02 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, SGM Raymond Barger, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-8, and to be confined for 7 days.

On 04 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, CPL Logan T. Kyle, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of murder, and one specification of death of an unborn child, in violation of Articles 118, and 119a, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for life with eligibility for parole, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 04 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, CPT Luis E. Ramirez, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of failure to obey a lawful general regulation, four specifications of abusive sexual contact, and two specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Articles 92, and 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 29 months, and to be dismissed from the service.

On 05 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, SSG Robert Ortiz, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of false official statement, in violation of Article 107, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-4, and 60 days of hard labor without confinement. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement disapproved the reduction in rank.

On 11 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, SPC Derick L. Stark, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his plea, of one specification of attempting to possess child pornography, in violation of Article 134, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be

reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 8 months, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 19 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Riley, Kansas, SPC Michel J. Newman, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of six specifications of false official statement, one specification of maiming, one specification of aggravated assault upon a child, and two specifications of child endangerment, in violation of Articles 107, 124, 128, and 134. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 10 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

On 20 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, PVT Primitivo F. Delgado, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, and one specification of making a false written statement, in violation of Articles 90, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 1 month for each specification. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement stated the confinement is to be served concurrently.

On 20 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Riley, Kansas, PVT Christopher R. Mora, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of failure to report, two specifications of incapacitation for duty from drunkenness, two specifications of wrongful distribution and broadcast of intimate visual images, and, in violation of Articles 86, 112, 117a, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 180 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad conduct discharge.

On 26 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, a Staff Sergeant, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of one specification of aggravated assault with a dangerous weapon, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ.

On 26 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, PFC Drew D. Brinn, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of absence without leave, in violation of Article 86, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, and to be confined for 14 days.

On 28 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, PVT Cordell B. Franklin, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of absence without leave, and one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, in violation of Articles 86, and 112a, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 84 days.

## Fourth Judicial Circuit

On 03 June 2019, on remand at a general court martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, MAJ Michael D. Thompson, United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officer members, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of rape, one specification of sexual assault, and one specification of assault consummated by a battery upon a child, in violation of Articles 120, and 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of assault consummated by a battery upon a child, two specifications of assault consummated by battery, and one specification of kidnapping, in violation of Articles 128, and 134, UCMJ. Previously, on 18 December 2014, at a general court martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, MAJ Michael D. Thompson, United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officer members, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of failure to follow a lawful order, one specification of assault consummated by a battery, and six specification of conduct unbecoming an officer, in violation of Articles 92, 128, and 133, UCMJ. Based on both the 2019 and 2014 convictions, the members sentenced the accused to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 20 years, and to be dismissed from the service.

On 04 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, PVT Sheldon P. Baxter, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of damaging non-military property, in violation of Article 109, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 44 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad conduct discharge.

On 06 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Wainwright, Alaska, PFC Nicholas C. Patton, United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, and to be confined for 45 days.

On 10 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, PV2 Christian F. Gomez-Rodriguez, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of false official statement, and two specifications of assault consummated by battery upon a child, in violation of Articles 107, and 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 90 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 45 days.

On 12 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Carson, Colorado, a Sergeant, was acquitted by a military judge of one specification of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ.

On 12 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, PV2 Sirena M. Williams, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge pursuant to her pleas, of one specification of desertion, one specification of absence without leave, one specification of failure to report, and one specification of failure to obey a lawful order, in violation of Articles 85, 86, and 92, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 44 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 14 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Camp Humphreys, Republic of Korea, a Specialist, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, of one specification of sexual assault, and one specification of adultery, in violation of Articles 120, and 134, UCMJ.

On 17 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Wheeler Army Airfield, Hawaii, SGT Artis E. Perkins, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E1, to forfeit \$1000.00 pay per month for 2 months, and to be confined for 2 months.

On 17 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Camp Foster, Japan, PFC Brandon S. Schlarb, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of resisting apprehension, two specifications of failure to obey an order, one specification of assault consummated by a battery, and one specification of drunk and disorderly, in violation of Articles 87a, 92, 128, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 4 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 18 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, MSG Ronnie T. Robertson, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of willfully disobeying superior commissioned officer, four specifications of false official statement, and one specification of larceny, in violation of Articles 90, 107 and 121, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-7, and to be confined for 4 months. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement suspended confinement for 10 months to allow restitution.

On 18 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, SGT Bradley G. Aydelotte, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of failure to report, one specification of aggravated assault with a dangerous weapon, and one specification of disorderly conduct, in violations of Article 86, 128, and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 19 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 19 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, a Private First Class, was acquitted by a military judge of two specifications of false official statement, in violation of Article 107, UCMJ.

On 19 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, PVT Aeric C. Adams, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of desertion, in violation of Article 85, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances for 2 months, and to be confined for 176 days. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 120 days.

On 19 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Camp Henry, Republic of Korea, SGT James E. Bowman, Jr., United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of four specifications of false official statement, and one specification of larceny of military property, in violation of Articles 107, and 121, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of false official statement, in violation of Article 107, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 60 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

On 20 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, PFC Mark J. Steele, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of dereliction of duty, one specification of false official statement, and one specification of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Articles 92, 107, and 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 30 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad conduct discharge.

On 21 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bliss, Texas, SSG Kerry T. Elevier, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of assault consummated by battery, and one specification of drunk and disorderly, in violation of Articles 128, and Article 134, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-4, and to be confined for 90 days.

On 21 June 2019, at a special court-martial convened at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, SPC Eric D. Kennedy, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of failure to report, six specifications of false official statement, and one specification of malingering, in violation of Articles 86, 107, and 115, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded, hard labor for 75 days, and restriction for 60 days.

On 24 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Camp Humphreys, Republic of Korea, a Sergeant, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, of one specification of attempted sexual assault, one specification of maltreatment, three specifications of sexual assault, one specification of indecent exposure, and one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Articles 80, 93, 120, 120c, and 128, UCMJ.

On 25 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Carson, Colorado, SPC Nicklas L. Moore, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 6 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

### **Fifth Judicial Circuit**

On 06 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Kaiserslautern, Germany, a Private, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of one specification of failure to obey a superior commissioned officer, one specification of dereliction of duty, and two specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Articles 90, 92, and 120, UCMJ.

On 11 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait, PVT Micheal D. Stokes, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of insubordinate conduct toward a noncommissioned officer, one specification of failure to obey a lawful general order, one specification of wrongful introduction of a controlled substance onto a military installation, one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance with an intent to distribute, and one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance, in violation of Articles 91, 92, and 112a. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 30 months, to forfeit all pay and allowances, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 26 months.

On 27 June 2019, at a general court-martial convened at Kaiserslautern, Germany, MSG Joseph T. Foley, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of violating a general order, one specification of violating a general regulation, and one specification of violating a lawful order, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. Contrary to his pleas, the accused was convicted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, of one specification of false official statement, in violation of Article 107, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of false official statement, and two specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Articles 107, and 120, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reprimanded, to be reduced to the grade of E-5, to forfeit \$3,037.00 pay per month for 2 months, to preform 60 days hard labor, and to be confined for 120 days.
