SUBJECT: Distinctive Insignia for the 364th Engineer Group, Allotted to the US Army Reserve

1. A distinctive insignia for the 364th Engineer Group is authorized. It is described as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A gold color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches in width overall consisting of a black tower with three merlons issuing from within a scarlet spade iron and all surmounted by a white enameled chevron bearing a scarlet fleur-de-lis.

SYMBOLISM

Scarlet and white are the colors used for Engineers. The heraldic tower together with the spade iron symbolizes military engineering and construction, the basic mission of the organization. The fleur-de-lis alludes to the unit's activation and service in France during WW II.

2. The distinctive insignia will be worn as prescribed in AR 670-5.
3. This authorization letter will become a permanent file of the organization in accordance with File No. 228-08, Organizational history files, AR 340-18-2.

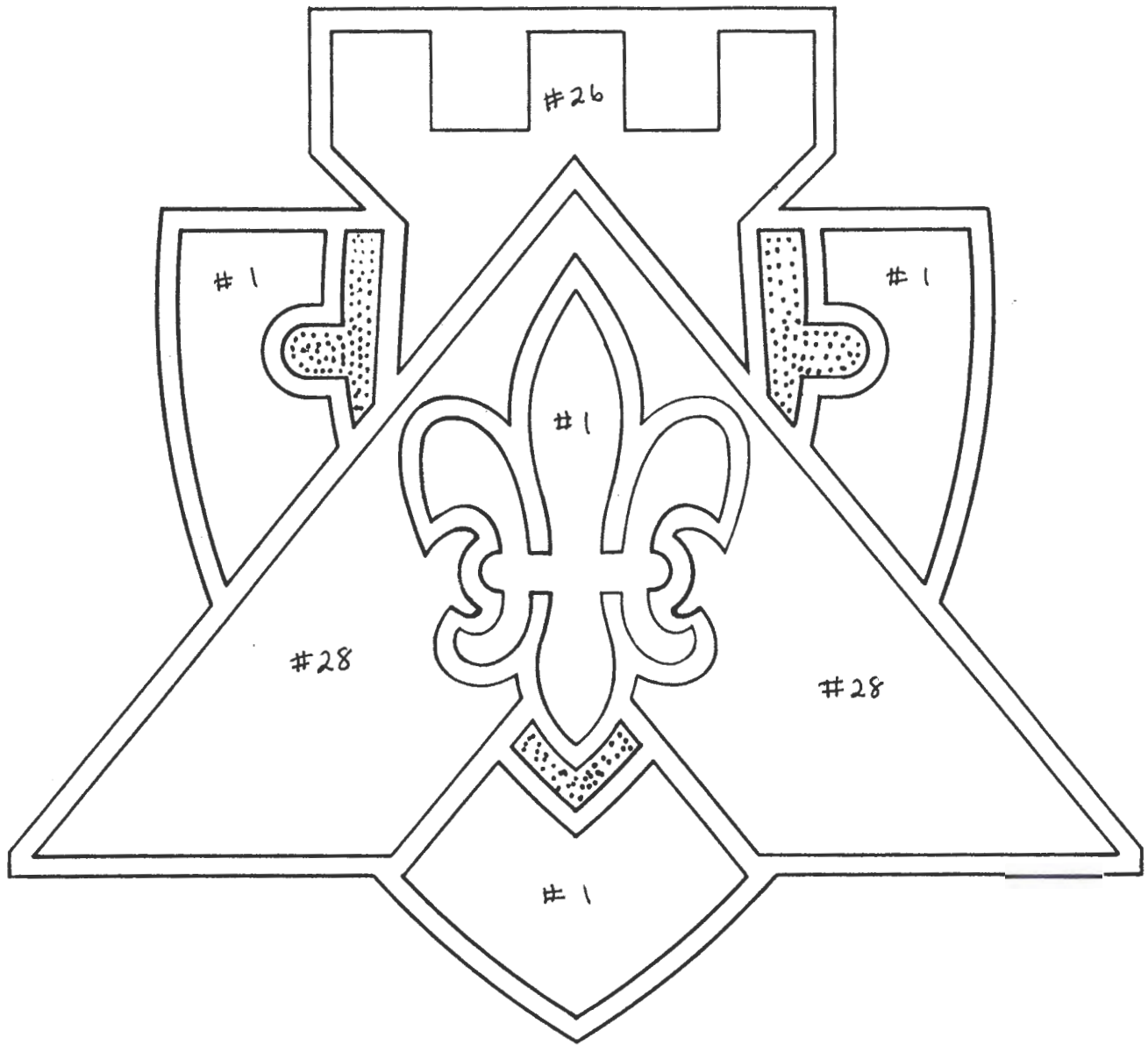

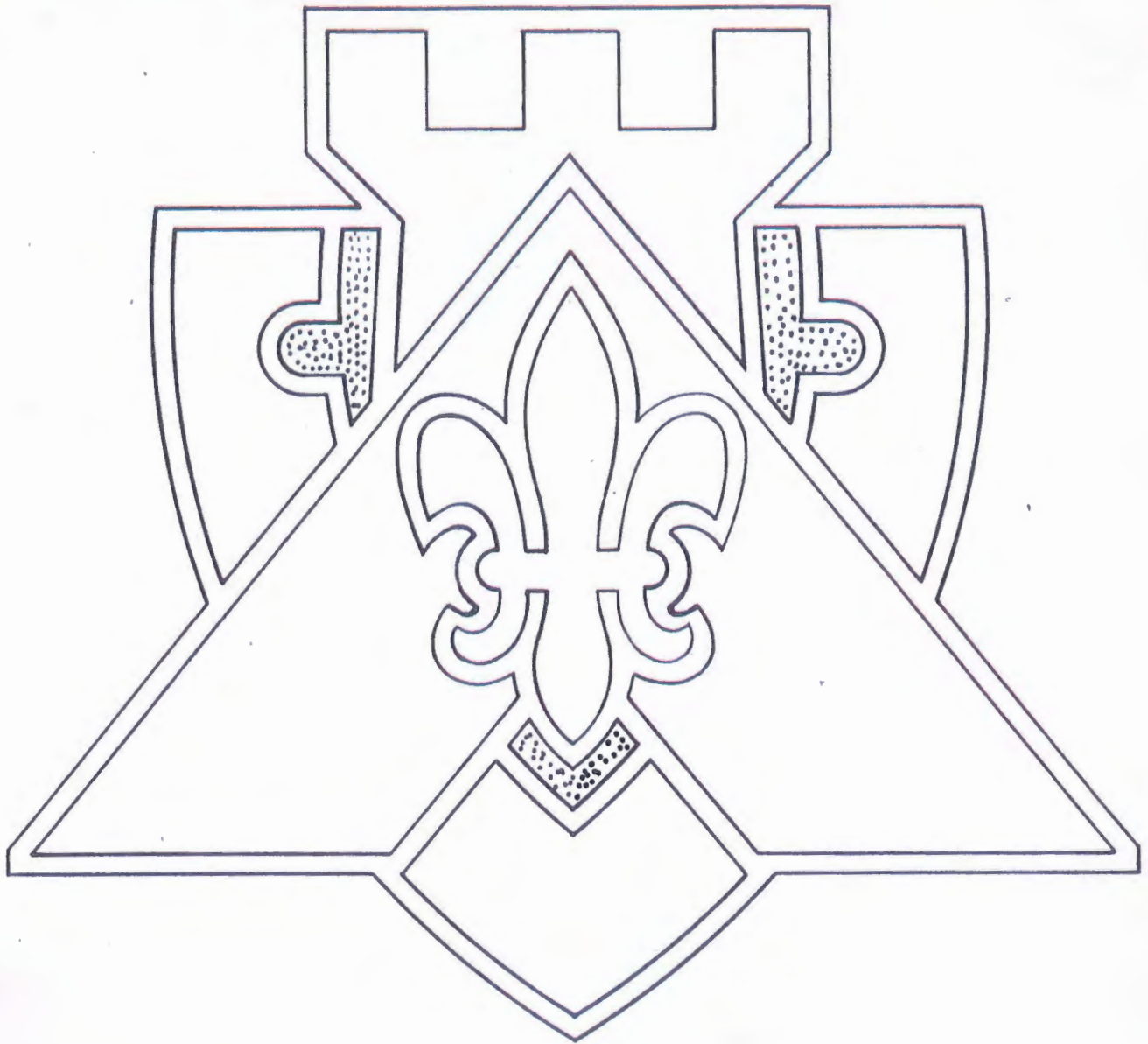

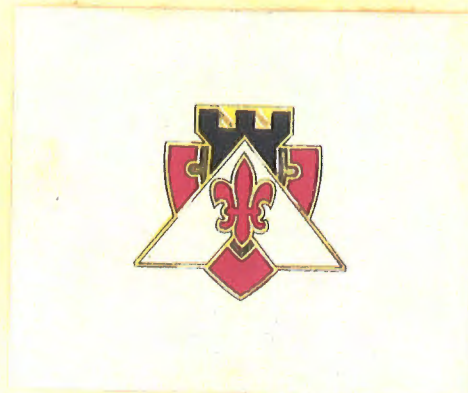
