SUBJECT: Authorized Insignia for the 16th Hospital Center

1. The following heraldic items are authorized for the 16th Hospital Center, effective 18 April 2020.

a. Distinctive unit insignia (Encl 1). The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a silver metal and epoxied device 1 1/8" (2.86cm) in height, consisting of a pair of wings, superimposed by a vertical sword, point downwards, the sword entwined with two serpents, facing, all silver, overall a blue square surmounted by a maroon cross extending past the square displaying a white vertical placed square, bearing a stylized silver parachute. All surmounting at base, a black scroll inscribed "**TRUST AND PERSEVERANCE**" in silver.

SYMBOLISM

The white lozenge alludes to care while the parachute combined with the stylized wings pay tribute to the jump community at Fort Bragg, whom the hospital center supports. Maroon and white are associated with the Army Medical Corps. The caduceus emblem is iconic to the medical profession.

b. Distinguishing colors IAW AR 840-10.

2. The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command is responsible for the procurement of flags. f. Equipment required and not on hand will be requisitioned in accordance with AR 710-2.

g. Personnel required will be provided in accordance with existing directives.

h. The official authorization document for unit to cite as authority for requisitioning personnel and equipment is MTOE 08976KFC06 FC0220, EDATE 18 April 2020. Personnel assigned to and equipment delivered to the site before activation of that unit will be assigned to and accounted for by the Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 16th Hospital Center Augmentation (Carrier). No authorization documents for carrier units are prepared in TAADS. Unit structure is contained in the official authorization document.

i. Unit is attached to Commander, 44th Medical Brigade, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; and Commander, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, Fort Bragg, North Carolina for training and readiness authority (TRA). TRA is the degree of Title 10 authority that operational commanders in a chain of command exercise on matters affecting the training and readiness of assigned or attached modular units. TRA is mission command authority delegated by CG, FORSCOM. Unless specified otherwise, TRA includes the authority to give direction for leader development, organizational training, and unit readiness (to include maintenance, manning, and equipping).

j. Commander, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, provides support (installation focus) in accordance with his roles and responsibilities as the Army Senior Commander.

k. Transfer and promotion authority will be in accordance with AR 614-100, AR 614-200, AR 600-8-19, and AR 600-8-29, respectively.

l. Commander, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, exercises general court-martial convening authority, original, and appellate jurisdiction under Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice; will be responsible for the general administration of military justice; and will take those administrative actions requiring action by an officer exercising general court-martial convening authority. Commander, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, may further attach the unit for the exercise of special court-martial convening authority, summary court-martial convening authority, and appellate proceedings under Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice.

m. Units undergoing reorganization, activation, or other force structure change will begin evaluating projected unit status under new MTOE no later than 120 days prior to EDATE. Units projecting C4 in one or more resource areas will request authorization to report C5 from FORSCOM no later than 90 days prior to EDATE in accordance with AR 220-1, Army Unit Status Reporting and Force Registration-Consolidated Policies.

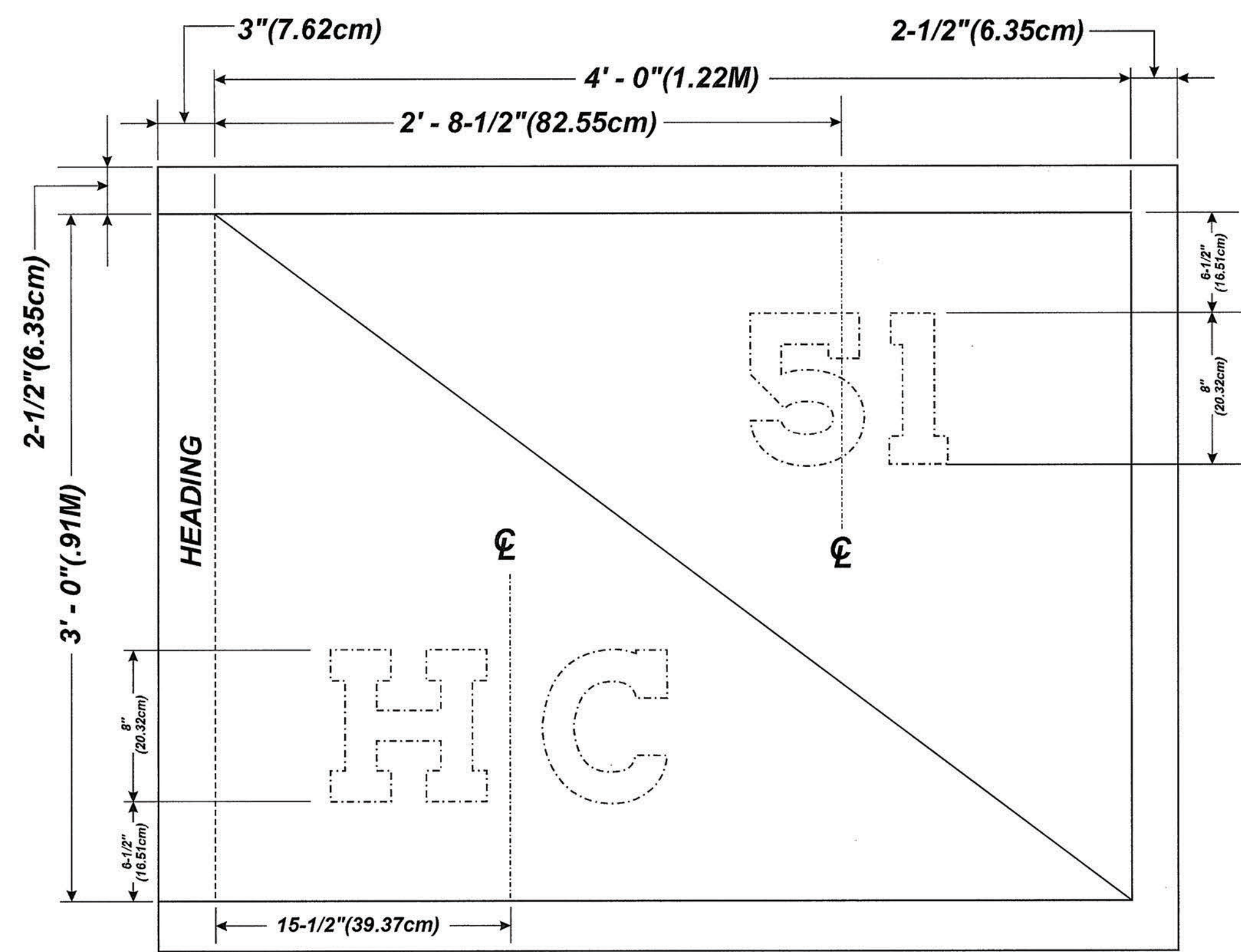

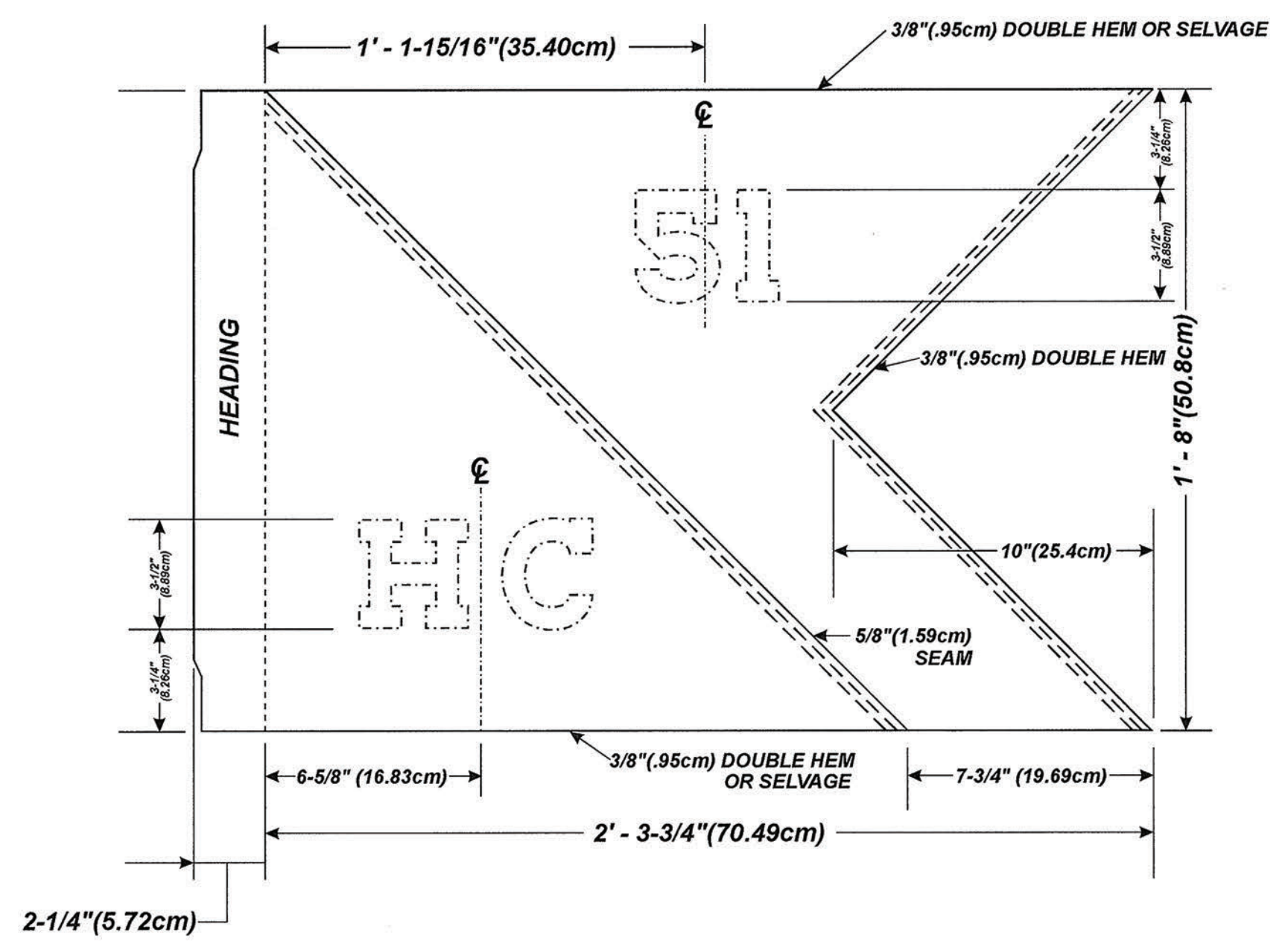

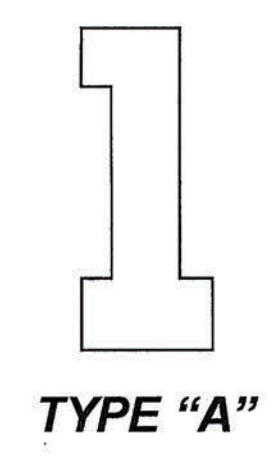
