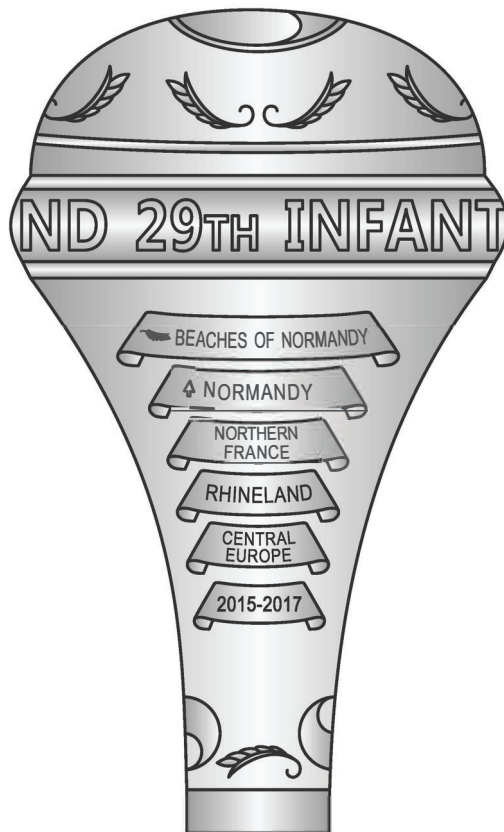
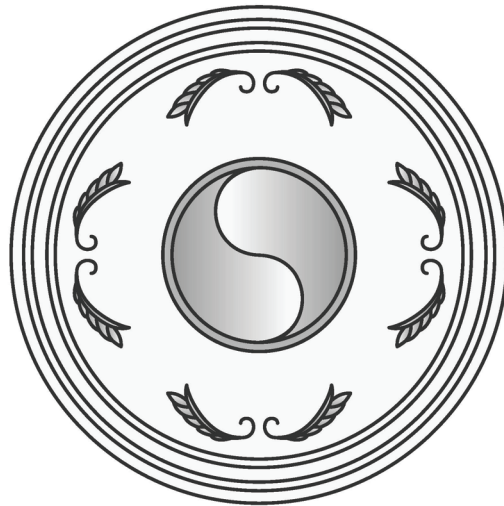

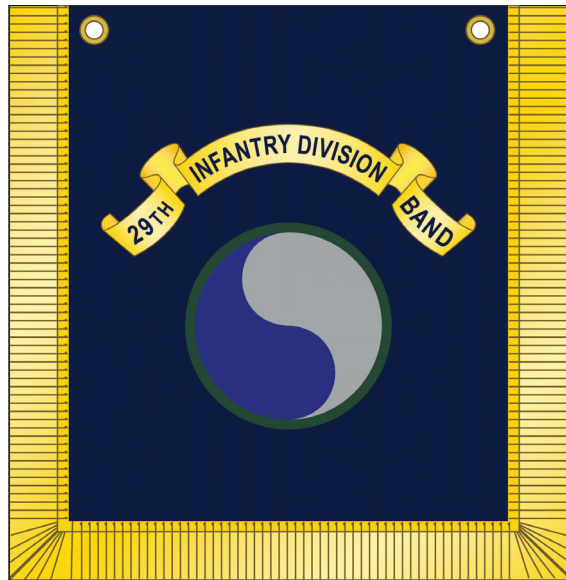

Description. On a dark blue field, the color taken from the Virginia State flag, a disc with a taeguk, the right half being blue and the left half gray, within a green border, is the authorized shoulder sleeve insignia of the 29th Infantry Division. Above the disc is a gold quadrupled parted scroll inscribed “29TH INFANTRY DIVISION BAND” in dark blue letters. To base is a silver star, which reflects Roanoke’s nickname “The Star City of the South.” Between the taeguk and silver star five World War II campaigns and an Army Superior Unit Award.

TABARD

Description. On a dark blue field, the color taken from the Virginia State flag, a disc with a taeguk, the right half being blue and the left half gray, within a green border, is the authorized shoulder sleeve insignia of the 29th Infantry Division. Displayed at top a yellow tripled parted scroll edged and inscribed “29TH INFANTRY DIVISION BAND” in dark blue.



DRUM

Description. On a dark blue field, the color taken from the Virginia State flag, a disc with a taeguk, the right half being blue and the left half gray, within a green border, is the authorized shoulder sleeve insignia of the 29th Infantry division. Displayed at top a yellow tripled parted scroll edged and inscribed “29TH INFANTRY DIVISION BAND” in dark blue. To base, six streamers parted three on each side inscribed with the Band’s campaign credits for the European-African-Middle Eastern Theater during World War II and Army Superior Unit Award.

MACE

Description. Displayed around the bottom of the mace, two taeguk symbols with a decorative palm in between five scrolls inscribed with the Band's campaign credits for the European-African Middle Eastern Theater during World War II and Army Superior Unit Award. The inscription "29TH INFANTRY DIVISION BAND" is around the band of the mace. The authorized shoulder sleeve insignia is displayed at the top of the mace, encircled by decorative palms, symbolizing Pacific service.

Background. The regalia was originally approved on 6 September 2016. The regalia was updated to reflect current campaign participation credit on 30 July 2020.
